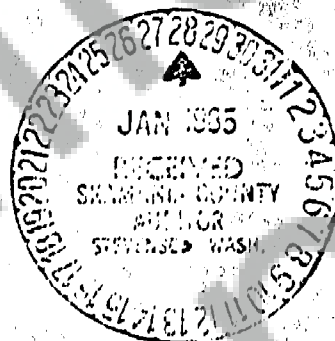

Provided however, that certain federal regulations may apply, in addition or in place of the above.

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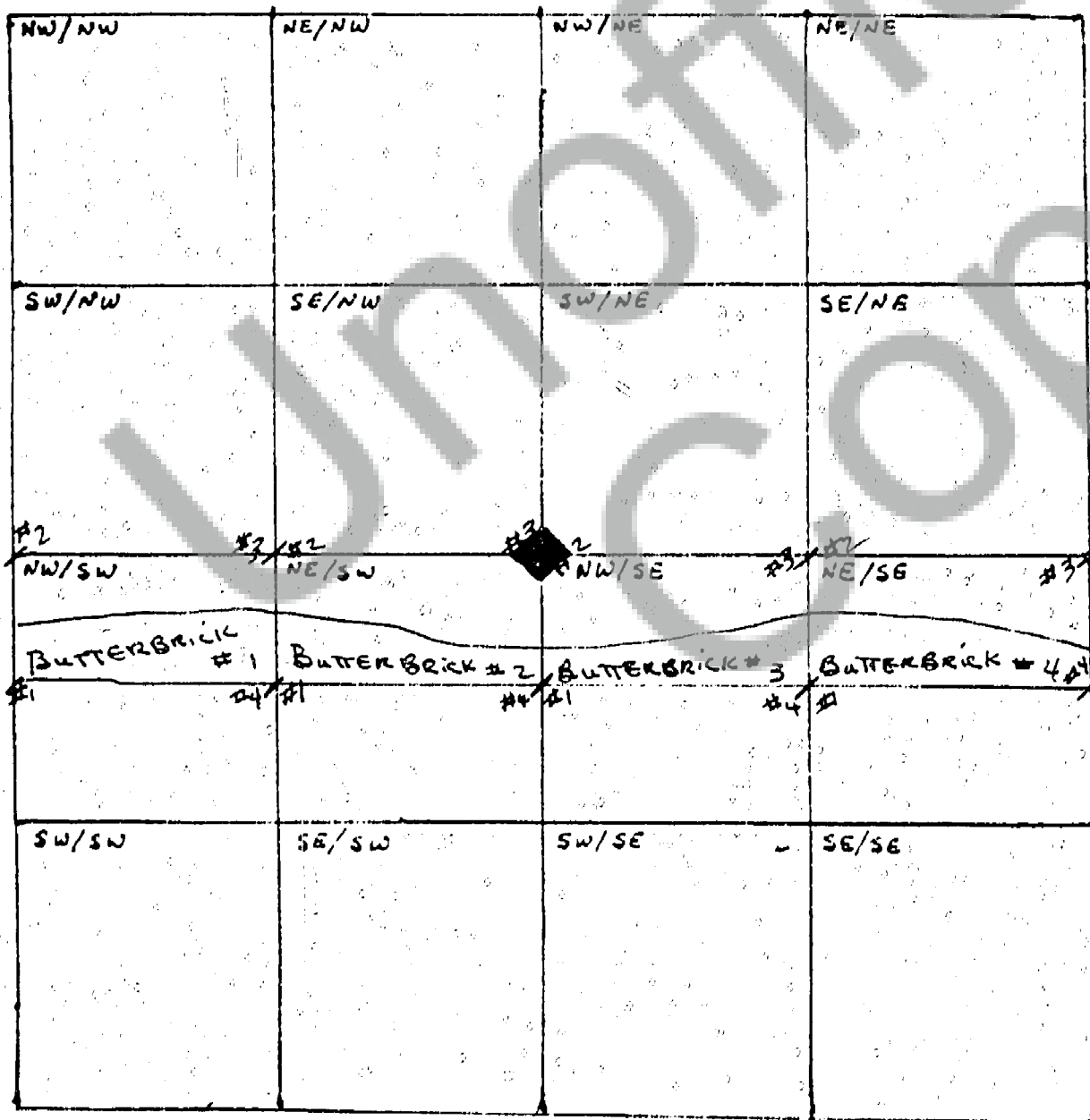

WHEN DRAWING YOUR CLAIM(S) USE AN ORDINARY RULER. $\frac{1}{8}$ " OF AN INCH WOULD BE 100 FEET SO A FULL SIZE LODE (600' x 1500') WOULD BE $3\frac{3}{4}$ " BY $17\frac{1}{8}$ ". A FULL SIZE PLACER (1320' x 660') WOULD BE $1\frac{3}{4}$ " BY $13\frac{1}{4}$ ".
