

## RELINQUISHMENT OF EASEMENT RIGHTS

WHEREAS, the STATE OF WASHINGTON, DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, by easement document dated April 4, 1966, was granted an easement over and across a tract of land, as hereinafter more specifically described, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a road to provide access for forest protection purposes only, said easement having been granted by Mr. Herbert Malarkey, of Portland, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, said easement was granted over and across the following described lands situated in Skamania County, Washington, to wit:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Washington State Department of Natural Resources does hereby surrender and relinquish all its right, title, and interest in and to the above granted easement rights, and all such rights, duties, and liabilities as may have been incurred under said grant of easement.
