WHEREAS, and the Washington State Department of Natural Resources no longer has any need for such easement rights, as was granted by said easement,

NOW THEREFORE, the Washington State Department of Natural Resources does hereby convey and quitclaim all its right, title, and interest in and to the aforesaid easement, to S.D.S. Company, of Bingen, Washington.
