QUITCLAIM DEED

WHEREAS, the STATE OF WASHINGTON, DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, by easement document dated October 15, 1971, filed for record under Auditor's No. 74107 in Volume 63, pages 449-454, in Skamania County Auditor's office, was granted an easement over and across a tract of land, as hereinafter more specifically described, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a road to provide access to and from State owned lands, said easement having been granted by CROWN ZELLERBACH CORPORATION, a Nevada Corporation, and

WHEREAS, said easement was granted over and across the following described lands situated in Skamania County, Washington, to wit:

The NW1/4NW1/4 of Section 3, Township 2 North, Range 7 East, W.M. and,

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Natural Resources no longer has need for such easement rights, as was granted by said easement,

NOW THEREFORE, the Washington State Department of Natural Resources does hereby convey and quitclaim all its right, title, and interest in and to the aforesaid easement, to Longview Fibre Company, of Longview, Washington, successor in interest to Crown Zellerbach Corporation for those lands herein described.


