## QUITCLAIM DEED

WHEREAS, the STATE OF WASHINGTON, DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, by easement document dated June 26, 1961, filed for record under Auditor's No. 58660 in Volume 49, pages 63-66, in Skamania County Auditor's office, and by easement document dated May 14, 1962, filed for record under Auditor's No. 60150 in Volume 50, pages 66-72, in Skamania County Auditor's office, was granted easements over and across a tract of land, as hereinafter more specifically described, for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a road to provide access for forest protection, reforestation, development and utilization including logging purposes only, said easements having been granted by Vera M. Borin of 6815 Middle way, Vancouver, Washington, and

WHEREAS, said easement was granted over and across the following described lands situated in Skamania County, Washington, to wit:

NOW THEREFORE, the Washington State Department of Natural Resources does hereby convey and quitclaim all its right, title, and interest in and to the aforesaid easement, to Longview Fibre Company, of Longview, Washington.


