1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration; description of Evidence Found: _____

This corner was established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor Jacob Richardson in July, 1895. It was found in May, 1916 by Frederick W. Rase during a survey he made in May, 1916. The corner had been destroyed by a rock slide, but the Fir, 30" in diameter, Section 36 B.T. was found scribed and in good condition in 1916.

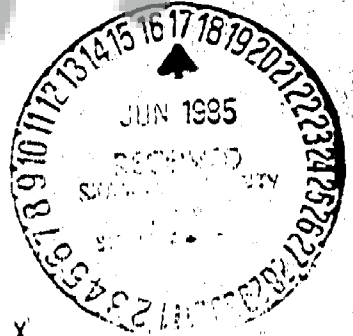
We found a ± 28" diameter Fir snag without bark and gnarled fire scars. There was some fairly recent axe work on a scar ± 4" above the ground. We sawed out scars, but found only pitch seams. No scribing or axe work was found. Original B.T. must have been bark scribed.

G.L.O. bearing and distance from this snag places the corner within 2 feet of the location matching 1916 witness corner to the East.

2. Describe Monument, Accessories and Corollary Data to Perpetuate this Corner Location. Diagram corner and indicate meridian and reference to map of record.

This corner falls on side of a vertical rock cliff so we set a witness corner on the East side of Wind River canyon.
