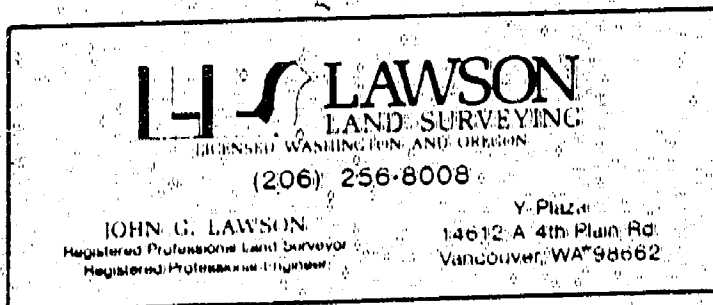

1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration; description of Evidence Found:

This corner was set by Frederick W. Rase during a survey in May, 1916. We found no sign of the original stone marked for corner, but did find two original bearing rocks.

Found original basalt boulder marked X BR, South 44° East, 26.73 feet.

Found original basalt boulder marked X BR, North 05° East, 20.46 feet.

2. Describe Monument, Accessories and Corollary Data to Perpetuate this Corner Location. Diagram corner and indicate meridian and reference to map of record.

LAWSON LAND SURVEYING Job # 34 - 83 - 260407 ; Date of Work: November, 1983

We set a 2 1/2" aluminum pipe and cap stamped, and referenced it as follows:

South 44° East, 26.73 feet to original basalt boulder marked X BR

North 05° East 20.46 feet to original basalt boulder marded X BR

North 77° East, 3.85 feet to a railroad spike at the base of a 20" Douglas Fir scribed RP with a metal tag.
