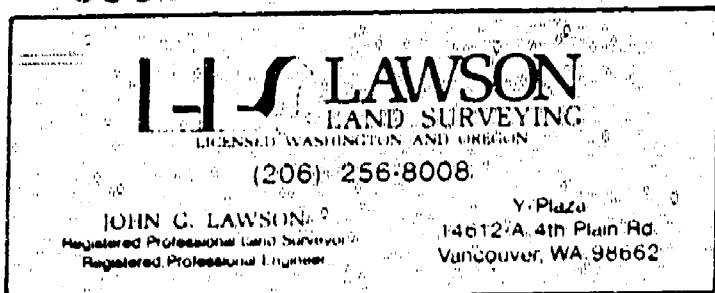

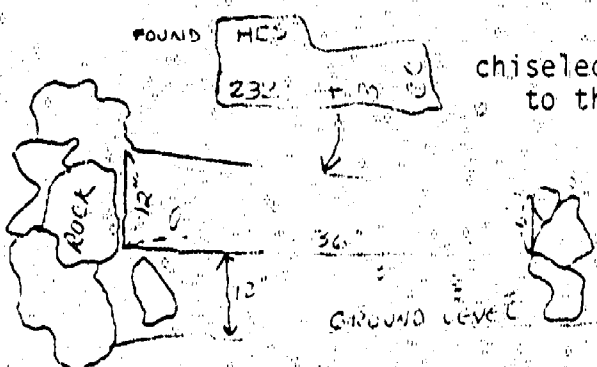

1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration; description of Evidence Found:

This corner was set by Frederick W. Rase during a survey in May, 1916. It was found by Richard A. Shaver and Ken Calkins of Crown Zellerbach Corporation on November 4, 1983.

Found ± 33" diameter Fir stump, North 79° West, 41.40 feet. Original BT call is for a 36" Fir, North 82° 10' West, 64 links (42.24 feet).
