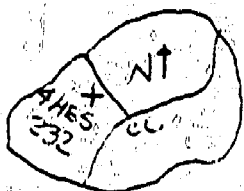

1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration: description of Evidence Found:

This corner was set by Frederick W. Rase during a survey in May, 1916.
We found sandstone 14" tall by 12" by 12" set 8" in the ground, with

chiseled on the side facing claim and C.C. chiseled on the Southeast side.



We found a sandstone outcropping with the following on the Southwest face:

X BR = Notch
HES 232

We found a mound of stone South 83° East, 5.5 feet from the corner stone under a downed 2-strand barbed wire fence which runs South 02° East by North 02° West.

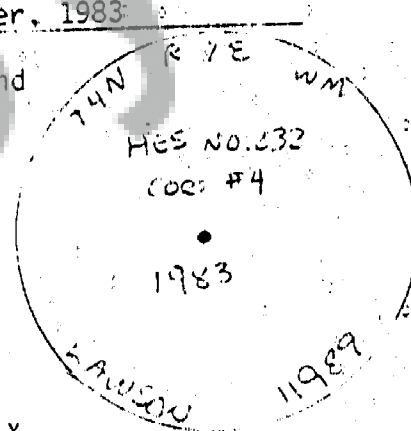
2. Describe Monument, Accessories and Corollary Data to Perpetuate this Corner Location. Diagram corner and indicate meridian and reference to map of record.

LAWSON LAND SURVEYING Job # 34 - 83 - 260407 ; Date of Work: November, 1983

We replaced the original stone found with a 2 1/2" aluminum pipe and cap stamped and referenced as follows:

North 64° East, 11.9 feet to a railroad spike at the base of a 10" Fir scribed RP with a metal tag.

North 85° West, 24.6 feet to a railroad spike at the base of a 36" Douglas Fir scribed RP with a metal tag.
