## SUPPLEMENTAL EASEMENT DEED

WHEREAS, by Easement Deeds dated February 9, 1951 and April 30, 1953, and Correction Easement Deed dated October 16, 1953, from Harold J. Broughton and Rita E. Broughton, husband and wife, and D. M. Stevenson and Angeline Stevenson, husband and wife, partners, dba Broughton Lumber Company, the United States of America acquired certain rights to construct, operate and maintain a water storage tank and pipeline to supply water to the Willard National Fish Hatchery in Skamania County, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America has a need to construct and maintain a building adjacent to the existing tank and to provide electric power to the site; and

WHEREAS, Broughton Lumber Company is agreeable to granting additional rights and uses within the existing easement areas for the above purposes:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above, the Grantor, Broughton Lumber Company, a Washington corporation, does hereby grant and convey to the United States of America and its assigns the right and easement to construct and maintain a building and appurtenances thereto upon Tract 6P-2, described in that certain document dated October 16, 1953, recorded on January 8, 1954, in Book 37, page 398, records of Skamania County, Washington, and as follows:

T. 3 N., R. 9 E., Willamette Meridian: In Section 11, that part of the Northwest quarter Northeast quarter (NWI/4NEI/4) bears N. 75° 04' E., 10.64 chains distant; thence N. 1° 10' E., 1.25 chains to Corner 2; thence S. 88° 50' E., 2.00 chains to Corner 3; thence S. 1° 10' W., 1.25 chains to Corner 4; thence N. 88° 50' W., 2.00 chains to the Place of Beginning;

and the further right and easement to construct, operate and maintain a buried power line together with appurtenances thereto, in, under and across Tract 6P, described in that certain document dated February 9, 1951, recorded October 22, 1951, in Book 34, page 46, records of Skamania County, Washington, and a follows:

T. 3 N., R. 9 F., Willamette Meridian: In Section 11, that part of the Northwest quarter Northeast quarter (NWI/4NE1/4) lying twenty-five (25) links on each side of the following-described center line: BEGINNING at a point in a spring of water, said point being S. 80°31'W., 17.32 chains from the Northeast corner of said Northwest quarter Northeast quarter (NWI/4NE1/4); thence S. 88°50°E., 9.05 chains; S. 66° 53' E., 7.84 chains; S. 60° 45' E., 0.353 chain to a point in the east boundary of the aforesaid Northwest quarter Northeast quarter (NWI/4NE1/4), said point being S. 4° 41' W., 6.31 chains from the Northeast corner of said Northwest quarter Northeast quarter (NWI/4NE1/4) the end of said center line.
