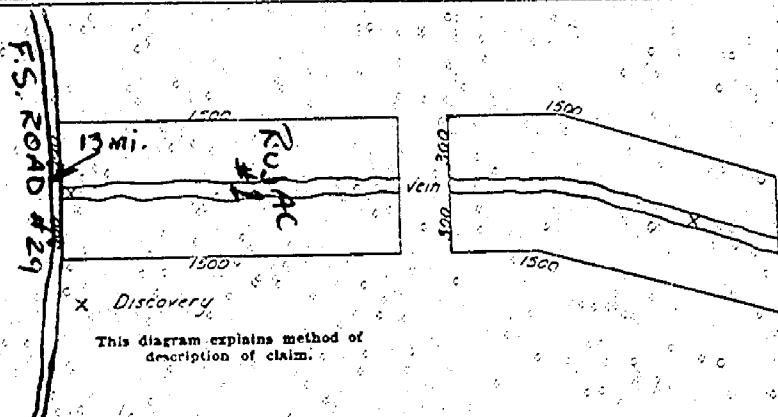


Notice of Mining Location

RUJAC #1 lode, vein, ledge or deposit (or placer ground), situated in the above State, County and Mining District, and further described as follows: Commencing at a post marked No. 1 at the Discovery shaft (cut or tunnel),

from thence 1500 feet in a EASTERLY (111°) direction to an end post marked

No. 2, thence 600 feet in a SOUTHERLY (201°) direction to a corner post marked

No. 3, thence 1500 feet in a WESTERLY (291°) direction to a corner post marked

No. 4, thence 600 feet in a NORTHERLY (21°) direction to a corner post marked

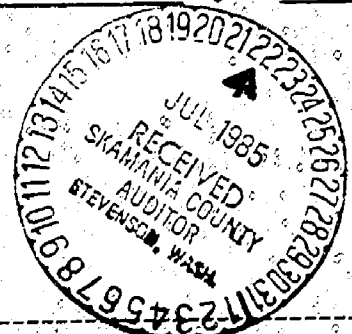
