DECLARATION OF DEDICATION OF REAL PROPERTY
TO EXCLUSIVE CEMETERY PURPOSES

Swigert Prindle Cemetery, a Washington nonprofit corporation, pursuant to RCW 68.24.030 hereby dedicates exclusively to cemetery purposes the real property delineated on the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A", situated in Skamania County, Washington and described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast Corner of Section 11, Township 1 North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian;

Thence South $1^{\circ} 11' 00''$ East a distance of 1210.61 feet more or less to the southerly line of the Burlington Northern Railroad right of way;

Thence South $68^{\circ} 24' 00''$ West, along said southerly line, a distance of 720.00 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

Thence South $68^{\circ} 24' 00''$ West a distance of 63.00 feet;

Thence South $21^{\circ} 36' 00''$ East to the meander line of the Columbia River;

Thence easterly along the meander line of the Columbia River to a point which bears South $21^{\circ} 36' 00''$ East from the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

Thence North $21^{\circ} 36' 00''$ West to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

EXCEPTING THEREFROM, a strip of land ten (10) feet wide adjacent to, and parallel to, the northern boundary of said property.

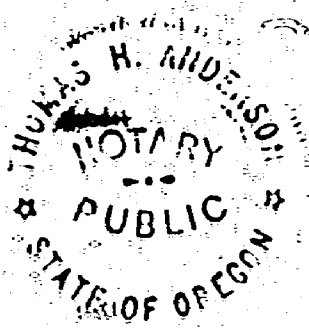

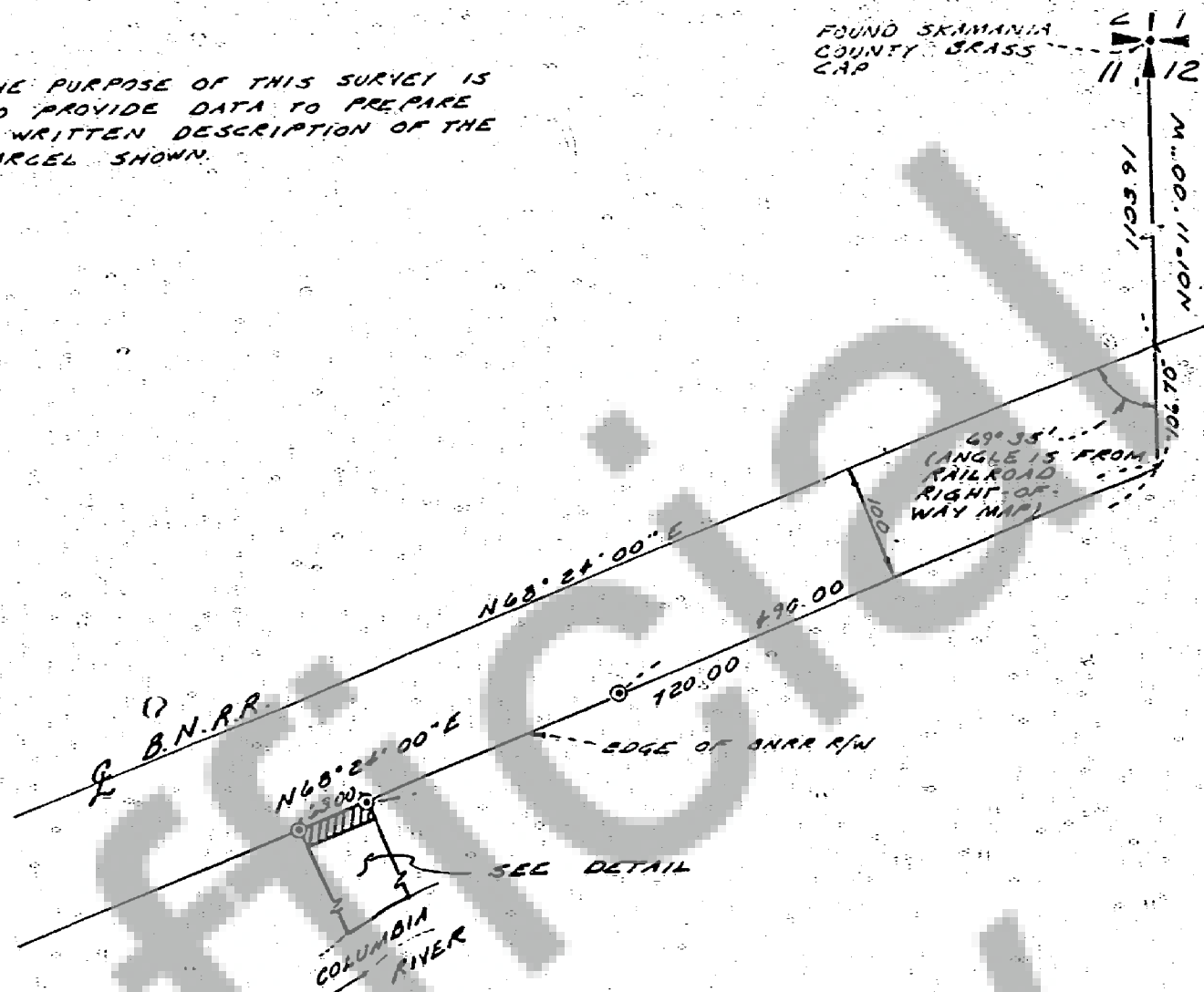

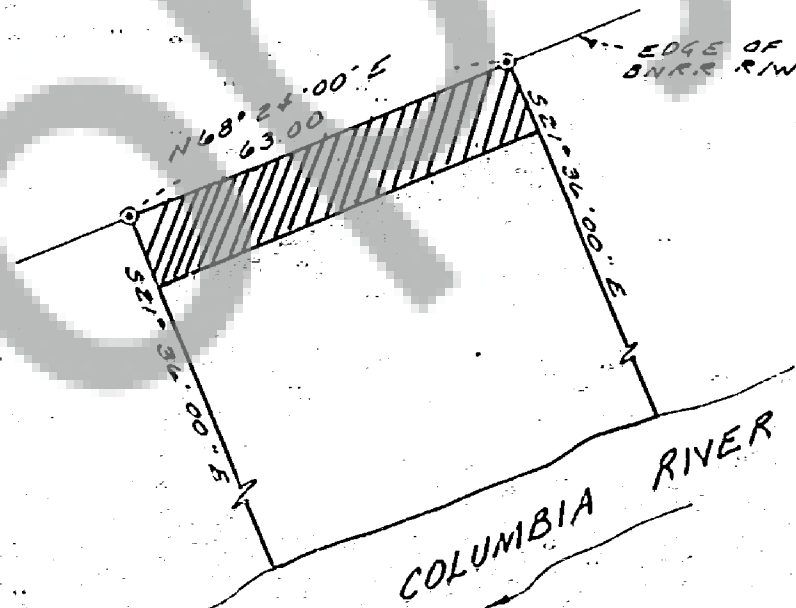
