

The North 50 feet of Lot 5 of Block Six of Johnson's Addition to the Town of Stevenson according to the official plat thereof on file and of record at Page 25 of Book "A" of Plats, records of Skamania County, Washington;

Also the following described tract of land, being a portion of McKinley Street vacated by ordinance of the Town of Stevenson:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 5 of Block Six of the said Johnson's Addition; thence West 25 feet; South 50 feet; thence East 25 feet to intersection with the West line of the said Lot 5; thence North 50 feet to point of beginning;

Subject to an easement for a natural gas pipeline granted to Columbia Gas Company, a corporation, over and across the West 15 feet of said tract.

AND that said SKAHANIA COUNTY has complied with the laws of the State of Washington necessary to entitle him/her to a deed for said real property.
