(g) If the Real Property is submitted to unit ownership. Lender or its designing may vote on any matter that may come before the intembers of the association of unit owners, pursuant to the power of attorney granted Lender in Section 16.2.

Walver, Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice.

Walver, Election of Remedies. Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of excenditure until repaid at the rate of 12 percent per annum or at the rate of the Note, whichever is higher. Expenses covered by this paragraph include (without limitation) all attorney fees incurred by Lender whether or not there is a lawsuit; the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors reports; appraisal fees, title insurance, and fees for the Trustee, to the extent permitted by applicable law
