- 1. <u>PARTIES</u>. The parties to the Agreement are as follows:
 - A. DELLA L. PALMER, a single woman (hereinafter referred to as "Landlord or "Seller"), and
 - B. LEWIS WILSON, a single man (hereinafter referred to as "Tenant" or "Purchaser").
- 2. PROPERTY. This Agreement concerns property owned by Seller, located in Skamania County, Washington, and legally described on Exhibit "A", attached hereto.
- Purchaser, for a period of up to one year, ending on October 9, 1987. This Lease may, however, end sooner than that date, in the event Terant exercises his option to purchase, or in the event of Tenant's breach leading to his eviction pursuant to the terms of Washington law.
- 4. OPTION. Tenant, as prospective Purchaser, and for separate consideration paid to the Landlord, has the option to purchase the property on those terms and provisions set forth in the Agreement between them. This Option will extend only until October 9, 1987, but will terminate prior to that date in the event that the underlying Lease is terminated.
