RELEASE OF EASEMENT

The UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, Department of Energy, Bonneville Power Administration, does hereby release and quitclaim unto the underlying fee owners of record, all its rights, title, and interest in and to the following described right-of-way and access road in the County of Skamania, in the State of Washington, acquired and more particularly described as:

ST-18 and ST-AR-5-1 - The entire 125-foot wide portion of Tract ST-18, being that portion lying northerly of a line crossing the right-of-way at station 272+23.2 in said Tract ST-18 that is perpendicular to the Bonneville Power Administration Bonneville-Coulee transmission line right-of-way in the W2SE4 of Section 35, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington. Station 272+23.2 is the end of the 87.5-foot-wide right-of-way and the beginning of the 125-foot right-of-way in Tract ST-18. ST-26 - That portion of the 100-foot-wide right-of-way to be released lies westerly of a line crossing the right-of-way at Survey Station 342+71.4 back = 333+52.0 ahead, in said Tract ST-26 that is perpendicular to the Bonneville Power Administration Bonneville-Coulee transmission line right-of-way, in the S2SE2SW2 of Section 25, Township 3 North, Range 7 East,

Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington. The boundaries of the 100-foot-wide right-of-way to be released lie 50 feet on each side of and parallel with the survey line for the Stevenson Tap to Bonneville-Alcoa No. 1 and 2 transmission line which is described with reference to the Washington Coordinate System, South Zone, as follows:

Beginning at Survey Station 318+43.1, a point on the south line of said Section 25, said point being S.88°21'00"E., 86.9 feet from the southwest corner of said Section 25; thence N.28°21'20"E., 318.2 feet to Survey Station 321+61.3; thence S.87°24'10"E., 2110.1 feet to Survey Station 342+71.4 back = 333+52.0 ahead; thence N.77°37'00"E., 311.6 feet to Survey Station 336+63.6, a point on the north-south quarter section line of said Section 25, said point being N.0°58'10"E., 324.7 feet from the quarter section corner on the south line of said Section 25,

acquired by Transmission Line Easement dated May 1, 1963, recorded May 31, 1963, in Book 51, Page 333, Skamania County, Washington Deed Records.

Said right-of-way and access road being released is shown on Bonneville Power Administration Drawing Nos. 125905 and 125906 attached hereto as Exhibit A, Pages 1, 2 and 3, and by this reference made parts hereof.

The rights herein released are no longer required for electric power transmission or access road purposes, and are released pursuant to the Acts of August 20, 1937, (50 Stat. 732, 16 U.S.C. § 832a), as amended, and June 30, 1949 (63 Stat. 385, 40 U.S.C. § 484), as amended, and regulations and delegations of authority issued pursuant thereto.
