

EASEMENT SUPPLEMENT

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 16th day of March, 1987, by and between BURLINGTON NORTHERN RAILROAD COMPANY, a Delaware corporation, herein called Burlington," and STATE OF WASHINGTON, acting by and through the Department of Natural Resources, herein called "State," WITNESSETH:

On the 24th day of June, 1985, Burlington, granted an easement referred to herein as the Original Easement, to the State, said Easement being recorded in the records of Skamania County, Washington, on July 9, 1985, in Volume 84 of Deeds, pages 743-746 under Auditor's File No. 99519. Said Original Easement is hereby supplemented as follows:

I

- A. Burlington for and in consideration of Four Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty and No/100 Dollars (\$4,720.00) for cost shared road and land damages, to be paid pursuant to Payment Agreement No. 1828 dated December 10, 1979, hereby grants and conveys to State, its successors and assigns, a permanent easement upon, over, and along rights of way forty (40) feet in width, over and across Government Lots 3 and 4, S1/2NW1/4, Section 2 and Government Lot 2, S1/2NE1/4, Section 3, Township 6 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in Skamania County, Washington, being twenty (20) feet on each side of the centerlines of a road or roads located approximately as shown in red for existing road on the attached "Exhibit A," and as shown in yellow for new construction on the attached "Exhibit B."

Subject as to said lands to all matters of public record.

- B. Provided, however, thirty (30) days prior to any construction, reconstruction, or development, the State shall submit to Burlington, for written approval, a complete and detailed plan of operation for the development of the right of way. The State's operations specified hereinabove shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the approved Plan of Operation in force at the time of the commencement of said operations and the State shall provide for the examination of the right of way with Burlington representative, before any construction, reconstruction, or development is commenced.

Except as herein supplemented all of the terms, conditions and reservations of the Original Easement shall remain in full force and effect.

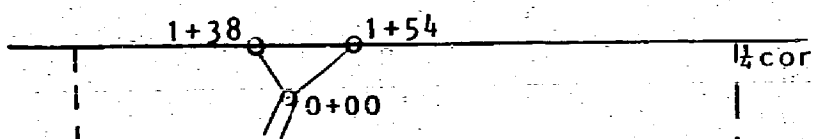

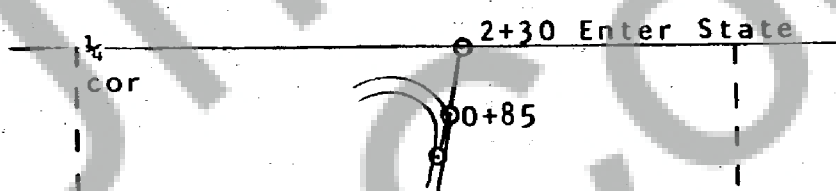


Government Lot 3
