The SWANEA of Section 34, T. 2 N., R. 6 E.W.M.; Except that portion thereof lying easterly of the centerline of the county road known and designated as the Butler Loop Road and southerly of Primary State Highway No. 14; and except that portion thereof lying westerly of the centerline of the county road known and designated as the Woodard Creek Road.

And except the following described tract of land: Beginning at a point marking the intersection between the northerly line of Primary State Highway No. 8 and the south line of the SWINEL of the said Section 34; thence turning an angle northwesterly and running on a course having an angle of 58°30' with the northerly line of said highway a distance of 100 feet; thence in a northeasterly direction along the westerly side of an old abandoned county road a distance of 200 feet to a point which is 172 feet distance northwesterly from a point on said highway which is north 58°01' east 200 feet from the point of beginning; thence southeasterly 172 feet to the above mentioned point on said highway; thence south 58°01' west 200 feet to the point of beginning.

PROVISIONS

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
