TERMINATION OF EASEMENT

THIS TERMINATION OF EASEMENT, dated this 20th day of July, 1987, by the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture,

WHEREAS, Burlington Northern Railroad Company (formerly known as Burlington Northern Inc., successor in interest to Northern Pacific Railway Company) granted to the United States of America, an easement (No. 25934-W) dated March 3, 1959, and recorded May 29, 1959, under Book 46, Page 128 of Deed Records, County of Skamania, State of Washington, over and across the following described premises:

Lots one (1), five (5), six (6), and seven (7), of Section thirty-five (35), in Township seven (7) North, Range six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian.

WHEREAS, the undersigned has determined that the United States of America has no further need for said easement.

NOW THEREFORE, this TERMINATION OF EASEMENT is executed for the purpose of showing that it has been determined that the United States of America has no further need for the easement and that the easement pursuant to its provisions has ceased and terminated and is hereby cancelled.
