This matter coming on for trial before the above entitled court on Tuesday, January 30, 1968, at the hour of 9:30 A.M., plaintiff being present in court and represented by her attorney, Lee J. Campbell, defendant being present in court and represented by his attorney, J. D. Searle, and evidence, oral and documentary, having been submitted by both parties, and the court having heard argument of counsel and being in all things advised and having heretofore made and entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, now, therefore, in conformity therewith,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

I

That the plaintiff, Wilma Long, be, and she hereby is, awarded a Decree of Divorce from the defendant, James P. Long.

II

That plaintiff be, and she hereby is, awarded as her sole and separate property the following:

Real property in Skamania County, Washington, described as follows:

That portion of Lot 3 of Strawberry Hill Tracts according to the official plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the south line of the said Lot 3 which is 20 feet west of the southeast corner of the said Lot; thence west along the south line
