

LAND CORNER RECORD

T. 4 N. R. 7E, W.M. Skamania County
Segregated Surveys: Closing corner Corner No. 2-1
Name: DLC, HES, Tract, Mining Claim, Indian Allotment, Federal Reserve, Townsite.

1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration:

This corner was originally set by Deputy Robert F. Whitham in 1903 under Contract No. 600.
Orig. corner tree-36" Fir
16" Fir N52 $\frac{1}{2}$ E-19 lks.
24" Fir S50 $\frac{1}{2}$ E-13 lks.

2. Description of Evidence Found:

Orig. 36" Fir corner tree, now a 36" D-Fir snag 30' tall-orig. marks must have been in bark as none remain-only some faint blazes.
Orig. 16" Fir now an 18" rotted D-Fir stub N55 $\frac{1}{2}$ E-12.5' no marks remain.
Orig. 24" Fir now a 16" rotted D-Fir stub S50 $\frac{1}{2}$ E-8.6' no marks remain.
DNR Reference Trees:
Now a 7" D-Fir S47 $\frac{1}{2}$ W-3.2' with Alum. nail on NE side.
Now a 9" D-Fir N82E-7.5'.
Now a 14" D-Fir N2W-31.9' with Alum. nail in West side.
R/R spike N43W-10.0'.

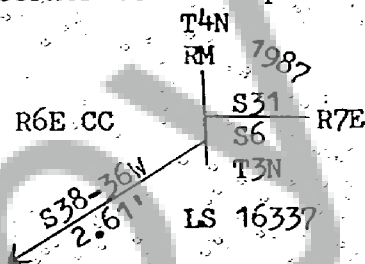

Set 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" Alum. pipe with a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Alum. cap RM from the corner to the cap N38-36E-2.61' stamped:

New Bearing Tree:

9" D-Fir N82E-8.6' scribed CCT4NR7ES31BT and with a 1" Brass disk stamped LS 16337.

Nailed 54-9 signs to BT's and corner tree & painted band & blazes red.
Nailed BT signs to BT's.
