1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration:

Originally established by GLO in 1859 with a post and two bearing trees. Subsequently restored by Clark La Barre in 1913 from "original witness tree." Mr. La Barre scribed two additional witness trees.

In 1979, Olson Engineering set a 3/4" iron pie with brass cap from Mr. La Barre's witness trees, which then were stumps.

Above-described pipe with unstamped cap.

Three Olson Engineering reference trees.

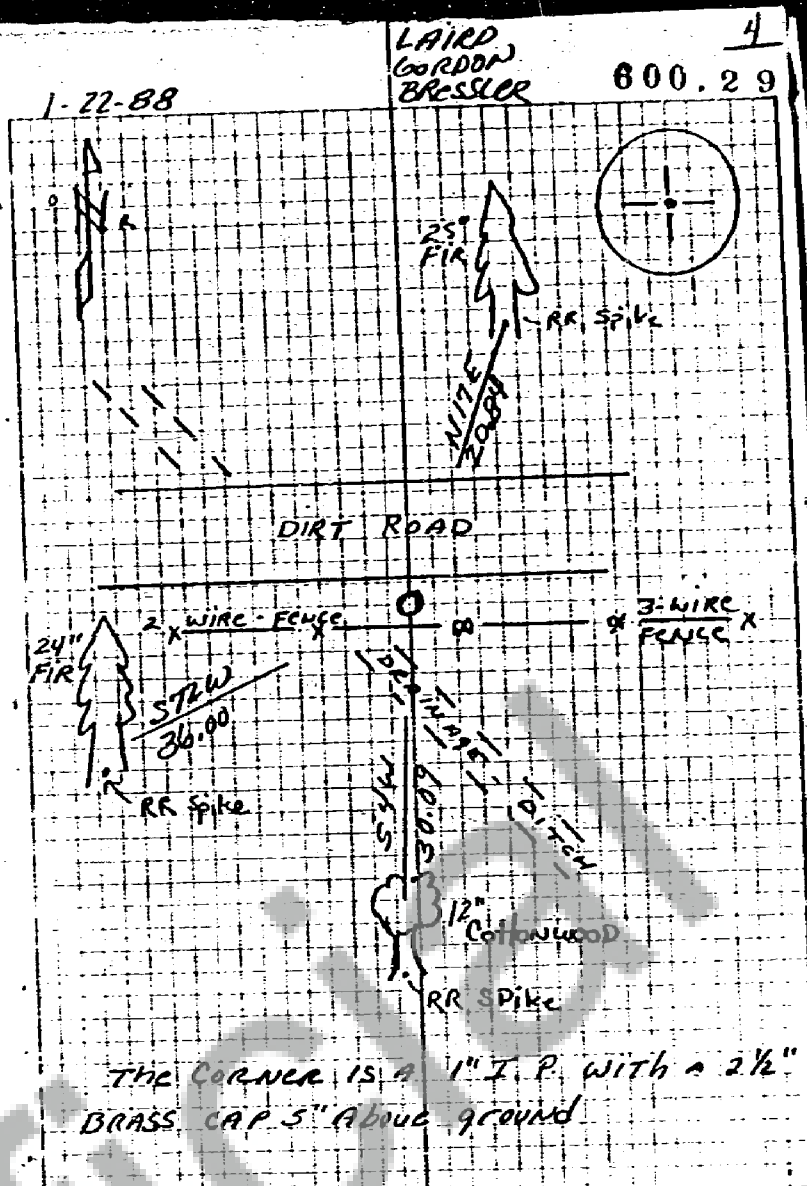
