COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT

NEWELL and MAYBELL CLARA NEWELL, as husband and wife, all separate property now owned or hereafter acquired by the said MAYBELL CLARA NEWELL, and

The parties hereto agree that upon the death of either, title to all of their property, real, personal or mixed, shall vest in

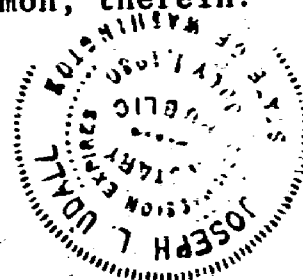
