TRUSTEE'S DEED

THE GRANTOR, ROGER D. published once between the 32nd and 28th day before the date of sale, and once between the 11th and 7th day before the date of sale; and further, included with this Notice which was transmitted to or served upon the Grantor or his successor in interest, a Notice of Foreclosure in substantially the statutory form, to which copies of the Grantor's note and Deed of Trust were attached.

- 8. The Grantor's successors in interest filed for relief under Chapter 7 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, thereby staying the Trustee's Sale. On March 9, 1988, the Trustee obtained from the United States Bankruptcy Court an Order granting relief from the automatic stay. The Trustee, in compliance with law, then executed and on March 25, 1988 recorded in the Office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, an Amended Notice of Trustee's Sale of said property as Auditor's File No. 104869.

The Trustee, in its Amended Notice of Trustee's Sale, fixed the place of sale as the entrance to the Skamania County Sheriff's Office, Skamania County Court House, Stevenson, Washington, a public place, at 10:00 o'clock a.m., and in accordance with law caused copies of the statutory Amended Notice of Trustee's Sale to be transmitted by mail to all persons entitled thereto and either posted or served prior to thirty (30) days before the sale; further, the Trustee caused a copy of said Amended Notice of Trustee's Sale to be published once between the 32nd and 28th day before the date of sale, and once between the 11th and 17th day before the date of sale; and further, included with the Amended Notice of Trustee's Sale which was transmitted to or served upon the Grantor or his successor in interest, a Notice of Foreclosure in substantially the statutory form, to which copies of the Grantor's note and Deed of Trust were attached.
- ll. All legal requirements and all provisions of said Deed of Trust have been complied with, as to acts to be performed and notices to be given, as provided by Chapter 61.24 RCW.
