PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that in accordance with Chapter 36.45 of the Revised Code of Washington, I TOM ARNOLD LOGGING, INC.

hereby present you with my claim for damages against the County of Skamania, State of Washington, with the information required to be given by RCW 36.45.020 as follows:

1. That the injury for which I claim damages against the County of Skamania, State of Washington, occurred on or about the 21st day of July, 1988.2. That the place of injury was Four miles north of Carson on the Wind River Highway.3. That the location and description of the defect which caused the injury are
Skamania County's 1980 International dump truck operated by David E. Ash turned
turned in between our 1979 Kenworth log truck and our 1964 Pierce log trailer
while our driver, Donald E. Morley was passing. Your driver had pulled over to the
right of the fog line, so our driver proceeded to pass, waved at your driver, who
waved back, and continued on when your driver turned into our loaded vehicle
between the truck and trailer. There were also "NO LEFT TURN" signs posted there,
4. That the injury is described as follows: The trailer was totaled, and a rear wheel
on the truck was ruined.5. That the amount of damages claimed is as follows: Truck Wheel: \$96.63
Trailer Parts: \$3,101.24; Trailer Labor: \$1,152.00; 7% Sales Tax \$304.49 = \$4,654.366. Driver #2 was SB on Wind River Rd, going to make left Turn. #2 Turned on Turn Signal prior to intersection with a private Access Road. #1 (a loaded logging Truck) began to make a pass of #2, And did not see Turn signal. #1 advised he thought #2 was slowing to let him go by. #1 was then stuck just in front of the log Trailer. #2 advised he did not see #1 until impact. #1 lost log Trailer causing load to drop onto the shoulder & Road; skidding @ 420 feet to Resting Point. Two witnesses saw #2's Turn signal on prior to #1 passing. There is also a "No Left Turn" sign 200' prior to the intersection.

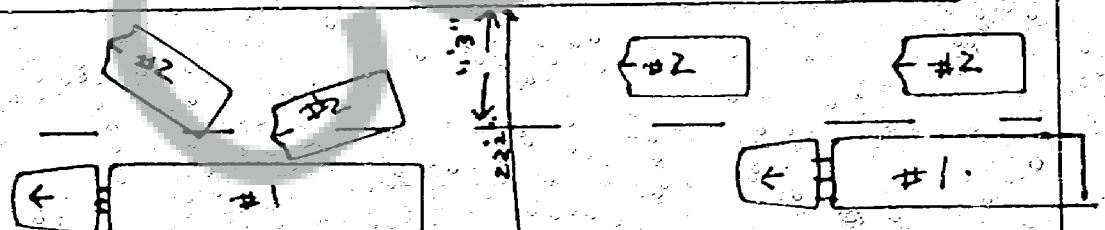

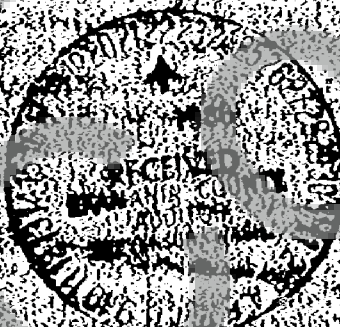

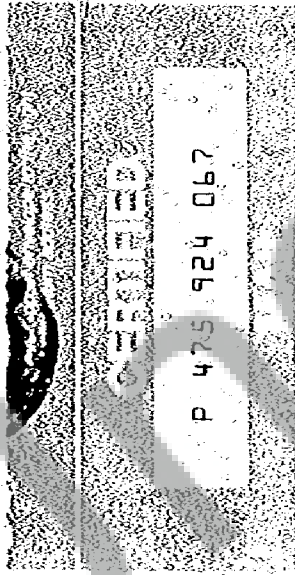
