Fri, Aug. 12.

This morning at about 10:45 a.m., my daughter and I were driving west on Cook-Underwood Road (Coming from White Salmon toward Mill A-Willard.) On the corner just to the east of the County Shed we met a county dump truck; both of our vehicles were driving well under the speed limit (35 mph - 40 mph?). There was no roadwork going on, no pilot car or anything to make me believe that I should slow down or stop my car. The dump truck was simply driving east on Cook-Underwood Rd and I was driving west.

Just as we met the dump truck, thousands of pieces of gravel flew up into my windshield, hood of my car and grill-headlight area. Both my daughter & I lifted our hands to our faces to protect (an instinct); both the truck driver and I continued driving in our respective directions. When the gravel flew at us (from the truck -

there was no gravel on the road that he simply stirred up. It felt for 2-3 seconds that he was actually dumping gravel on us - and with both of us moving, the force of the gravel hitting our car was much stronger than just flying gravel from the road.)

I immediately looked at windshield for breakage and saw only 1 hole in the glass with perhaps 1-inch streaks coming from the hole. I also noticed thousands of tiny dirt marks the gravel had left.

I met Bob Estey a few minutes later, stopped him and told him of the incident. He asked me to fill out an accident report.

When I got home and looked over the car, I found the 1 hole in the windshield, various paint chips on the hood and a front headlight was badly cracked.

Also, paint chipped off of both doors on drivers' side of the car.
