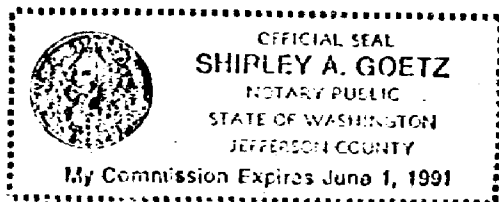

## **SUMMARY REPORT on LUCKY BREAK EXPLORATION PROGRAM MARCH 1 to AUGUST 31, 1988**

The Lucky Break Mine is located at Camp Creek, east of McCoy Creek, 18 miles south of Randle, Washington.

The property comprises 43 unpatented claims and encloses an area of 880 acres. It is currently held under agreement by Lucky Break Gold Inc.

A detailed description of the history of the property is presented in a June 1987 report by T.C. Scott, F.G.A.C.

A program of diamond drilling, geochemical sampling and geological mapping was conducted during the period March 1 to August 31, 1988. Grid work and drilling was completed in June with final geological mapping, core sampling and reporting completed by August 31, 1988.

Work was done on the northeast rim of a major intrusive stock where small high grade veins containing Cu, Pb, Zn and Au had been encountered by previous operators. This area contained diorite, hornfels and breccia. The target was these alteration zones on the rim of the stock.

No ore-grade intersections were encountered in drilling although significant zones of alteration anomalous in precious metals were noted. A recommendation to continue exploration of these is made.

A full report on drilling and geology was completed in August and provided to Lucky Break Mines Inc.
