Robert H. Burger Claimant, vs. Hamberton Bros. Mill

Notice is hereby given that Robert H. Burger of CLACKAMAS county, State of Washington, claims a lien upon 147,380 BF of logs, being about 585 in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Clark county, State of Washington, are marked thus K Stones and are now lying in Transporting, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in Transporting Logs; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Hamberton Bros; that Mochake Logging employed said Robert H. Burger to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said Mochake Logging agreed to pay the said Robert H. Burger for such labor and assistance State Rate, that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Robert H. Burger, who performed labor upon and assisted in Transporting said Logs for the period of 12 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said Mochake Logging between the 2 day of Aug. 1988 and the 18 day of Aug. 1988; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 18 day of Aug. 1988; and sixty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$5349.12; that no part thereof has been paid except None, and there is now due and remaining upon thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$5349.12, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs. The said Robert H. Burger also claims a lien on all said logs now owned by said Hamberton Bros. Mill of said county to secure payment for said logs, spars, piles or other timber, lumber or shingles herein described.
