Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax reglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition therato) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Inlerests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security Interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment fien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(1) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of Subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In **65** of the District at Ca the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of (2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be altusted -(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of fien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be downed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is lected, and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United

States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of faw regarding the form or content of a

- (g) Refiling O1 Notice. For purposes of this

(1) General Ruie. — Unless notice of tien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filling. — A notice of lien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only. (A) if -

(i) such notice of lies is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and -

(8) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to

(3) Required Reffling Period. — in the case any notice of lies, the term "required refling period" means-(A) the one-year period enling 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assess ment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lien

6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property. Sec.

(a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such agulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforcable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount accessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Dis-closure of Returns and Return Information.

(i) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes, -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. - If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property
