

Notice of Location of Placer Claim

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, who is a/are (or ha... declared... intention to become) citizen s of the United States, ha ve on this 22 day of April, 1989 discovered at the place where this notice is posted a valuable placer deposit bearing Gold and other valuable minerals, and do hereby locate and claim same as the MISS MOLLY Placer Mining Claim.

This claim is situated in the Copper Creek Mining District, Section 30, in Township 4N Range 5E Comprising of: N 1/2 of NW 1/2 SW 1/2 SE 1/2 and S 1/2 of SW 1/2 NW 1/2 SE 1/2 and all SE 1/2 NE 1/2 SW 1/2

The point of discovery, whereon this notice is posted is situated 10' North of Post #1 being the SE corner of NE 1/2 SW 1/2 of section 30 T4N R5E

and from thence the boundaries of said claim are marked and described as follows:

From Post #1 660' west to Post #2 being SW corner of SE 1/2 NW 1/2 SW 1/2 thence 660' north to Post #3 being NW corner of SE 1/2 NW 1/2 SW 1/2 thence 660' east to Post #4 being NE corner of SE 1/2 NW 1/2 SW 1/2 thence 330' south to Post #5 being NW corner of S 1/2 of SW 1/2 NW 1/2 SE 1/2 thence 660' east to Post #6 being NE corner of S 1/2 of SW 1/2 NW 1/2 SE 1/2 thence 660' south to Post #7 being SE corner of N 1/2 of NW 1/2 SW 1/2 SE 1/2 thence 660' west to Post #8 being SW corner of N 1/2 of NW 1/2 SW 1/2 SE 1/2 thence 330' north to Close Post #1

Note #1 The first 330' between Posts #7 and #8 abutts claim #96191-LD (BLM) "Soundough #3" Carroll, M.

Note #2 At approximately the center point between Posts #7 and #8 the line passes NW corner of bridge on RD #4109. Portions of this claim are RELOCATIONS and are deemed abandoned.

for the reasons: (1) No assessment work filed with BLM for 1988.

(2) Claim does not conform to legal U.S. survey section lines. (3)

Notice of location must be recorded within thirty days from the date of discovery at the office of the auditor of the county in which such discovery was made. Twenty Acres may be included in one placer claim and if located on surveyed land it must be according to legal subdivisions.

Care must be taken to fully describe the claim with reference to natural objects and permanent monuments or survey description, so that the boundaries can be readily traced. The blank spaces in this form must be carefully and properly filled out.

The discoverer must perform labor upon such location in developing the same to an amount which shall be equivalent in the aggregate to at least \$10.00 worth of such labor for each twenty acres, or fractional part thereof, contained in such location or claim, within sixty days from the date of discovery, and upon performance of such labor, file with the auditor of county an affidavit showing such performance and generally the nature and kind of work so done. Provided however, that certain federal regulations may apply, in addition or in place of the above.




