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DEED OF TRUST

THIS DEED OF TRUST IS DATED 05-02-1989, AMONG STEPHEN N CALEY and PHYLLIS C CALEY, HUSBAND AND WIFE ("GRANTOR"), whose address is MPO 57R SKAMANIA LANDING RD, SKAMANIA, Washington 98648; Seattle-First National Bank ("LENDER"), whose address is Vancouver Branch, 805 Broadway, Vancouver, Washington 98660; and OWTR&J CORP. ("TRUSTEE"), whose address is 2600 CENTURY SOUARE, 1501 4TH AVE, SEATTLE, WA 98101.

CONVEYANCE AND GRANT. For valuable consideration, Grantor conveys to Trustoe for the benefit of Lender as Beneficiary all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fortures; all easements, rights of way, and appurtenances; and all rights, royalties and profits relating to the real property (including minerals, oil, gas, water, and the like), and all ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights) located in SKAMANIA County, State of Washington (the 'Real Property'), legally described as:

LOT 23, BLOCK 1, WOODARD MARINA ESTATES, ACCORDING TO THE RECORDED PLAT THEREOF, RECORDED IN BOOK "A" OF PLATS, PAGE 114, IN THE COUNTY OF SKAMANIA, STATE OF WASHINGTON.

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as MPO 57R SKAMANIA LANDING RD, SKAMANIA, Washington 98648.

In addition, Grantor unconditionally and irrevocably assigns to Trustee all of Grantor's right, true, and interest in and to the Income (including all rents) from the Property, SUBJECT HOWEVER to the right, power and authority hereinafter given to Lender to collect and apply such Income. Further, Grantor grants Beneficiary a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Income and the Personal Property described below.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Deed of Trust:

Beneficiary. The word "Beneficiary" means Seattle-First National Bank, which also is referred to as "Lender" in this Deed of Trust.

Borrower. The word "Borrower" means STEPHEN N CALEY and PHYLLIS C CALEY. The words "Borrower" and "Grantor" are used interchangeably in this Deed of Trust.

Deed of Trust. The words "Deed of Trust" mean this Deed of Trust among Grantor, Lender, and Trustee, and include without limitation all assignment and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Income.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means STEPHEN N CALEY and PHYLLIS C CALEY. The words "Grantor" and "Borrower" are used interchangeably in this Deed of Trust.

Improvements. The word "Improvements" means without limitation all existing and future buildings, structures, facilities, additions and similar construction on the Real Property.

Income. The word "Income" means all rents, revenues, income, issues, and profits from the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Granter under this Deed of Trust, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Deed of Trust.

Note. The word "Note" means the note or credit agreement dated 05-02-1989 in the principal amount of \$12,000.00 from Borrower to Lender, together with all renewals, extensions, modifications, refinancings, and substitutions for the note or agreement. The currently scheduled final payment of principal and interest on the Note will be due on or before 05-15-1999.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property owned by Grantor, now or subsequently attached or affixed to the Real Property, together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for any of such property, and together with all proceeds (including insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of such property.

Property. The word 'Property' means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the real property described above.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include any promissory notes, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, and all other documents executed in connection with this Deed of Trust or the Indebtedness, whether now or hereafter existing.

Trustee. The word "Trustee" means DWTR&J CORP, and any successor trustee.

THIS DEED OF TRUST, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF INCOME AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE INCOME AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS AND AGREEMENTS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS DEED OF TRUSY AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS, AND IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Deed of Trust as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY

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Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Income from the Property. The Real Property is not used principally for agriculture or farming purposes.

Duty to Maintain. Greetor shall maintain the Property in first class condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property never has been, and never will be so long as this Deed of Trust remains a lien on the Property, used for the generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous substance, as those terms are defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1990, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), applicable state laws, or regulations adopted pursuant to either of the foregoing. Grantor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Lender against any and all claims and losses resulting from a breach of this provision of the Deed of Trust. This obligation to indemnify shall survive the payment of the Indebtedness and reconveyance of the Property.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall neither conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property or any portion thereof, including without limitation removal, or alienation by Grantor of the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), or soil, or gravel or rock products without prior consent of Lender.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demotish or remove any Improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. Lender shall consent if Grantor makes arrangements satisfactory to Lender to replace any Improvements which Grantor proposes to remove with Improvements of at least equal value.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable imes and upon reasonable notice to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Property.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or surety bond (reasonably satisfactory to Lender) to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, that from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Deed of Trust upon the sale or transfer of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest therein, without the Lender's prior written consent. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of real property or any right, title, or interest therein, whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; by outright sale; deed; instalment sale contract; land contract; contract for deed; leasehold interest with a term greater than three years, lease-option contract; sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to this Real Property; or any other method of conveyance of real property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than 25% of the voting stock of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by "aderal law or by Washington law."

TAXES AND LIENS,

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due before they become delinquent all taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Deed of Trust, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. If a fien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within 15 days after the lien arises or, if a fien is filed, within 15 days after Grantor has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien or deposit with Lender, cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs, attorney lees, or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obligee under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least 15 days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanics, materialmens, or other construction lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$1,000.00. Grantor will on request furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE.

Maintenance of insurance. Granter shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Granter shall deliver to Londer certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of 10 days prior written house to Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used to pay any amounts owing to Lender under this Dead of Trust, then to prepay accrued interest, and then principal of the indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inute to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Doed of Trust at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Doed of Trust, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Deed of Trust or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender may, at its option, on Grantor's behalf take the required action and any amount that it expends in so doing shall be added to the Indebtedness. Amounts so added shall be payable on demand with interest from the date of expenditure until paid at the Note rate. The rights provided for in this section shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. By taking the required action, Lender shall not cure the default so as to bar it from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE.

Title. Grantor warrants that it holds merchantable title to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in any policy of title insurance issued in lavor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Deed of Trust.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of the Trustee of Lender under this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall defend the action at its expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Granior warrants that its use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

CONDEMNATION.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor, Lender, or Trustee in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceedings in condemnation are filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAX BY STATE.

State Taxes Covered. The following shall constitute state taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Deed of Trust or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by this Deed of Trust; (b) a specific tax on any Grantor which the taxpayer is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Deed of Trust; (c) a tax on this type of Deed of Trust chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Note; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by any Grantor.

Remedies. If any state tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Deed of Trust, this event shall have the same effect as a default, and Lender may exercise any or all of the remedies available to it in the event of a default unless the following conditions are met: (a) Granter may lawfully pay the tax or charge imposed by the state tax, and (b) Granter pays or offers to pay the tax or charge within 30 days after notice from Lender that the tax law has been enacted.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fortures or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Washington Uniform Commercial Code.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's security interest in the Income and Personal Property. Grantor hereby appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney in fact for the purpose of executing any documents necessary to perfect or continue the security interest granted in the Income and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Deed of Trust in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file copies or reproductions of this Deed of Trust as a financing statement. Grantor will reimburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property and make it available to Lender within three days after receipt of written demand from Lender.

Addresses. The mailing address of Grantor (debtor) and the mailing address of Lender (secured party) from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Deed of Trust may be obtained (each as required by the Washington Uniform Commercial Code) are as stated on the first page of this Deed of Trust.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If all of the Indebtedness is paid when due and Grantor otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Deed of Trust and the Note, Lender shall execute and deliver to Trustee a request for full reconveyance and shall execute and deliver to Grantor suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lender's security interest in the Income and the Personal Property. Any reconveyance fee required by law shall be paid by Grantor, if permitted by applicable law.

DEFAULT. The following shall constitute events of default:

Default on Indebtedness. Borrower fails to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Deed of Trust to make any payment for taxes or insurance, or for any other payment necessary to prevent filing of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compliance Default. Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Deed of Trust, the Note or in any of the Related Documents. If such a failure is curable and if Grantor has not been given a notice of a breach of the same provision of this Deed of Trust within the preceding 12 months, it may be cured (and no event of default will have occurred) if Grantor, after receiving written notice from Lender demanding cure of such failure: (a) cures the failure within 15 days; or (b) if the cure requires more than 15 days, immediately initiates steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and completes all reasonable and necessary steps sufficient to produce compliance as soon as reasonably practical.

Breaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Deed of Trust, the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, false in any material respect.

Insolvency. Insolvency, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or Washington law, the death of Grantor (if Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an event of default under this Deed of Trust.

Foreclosure, etc. Commencement of foreclosure, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor against any of the Property. However this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and furnishes reserves or a surety bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

Leasehold Default. If the interest of Grantor in the Property is a lease of interest, any default by Grantor under the terms of the lease, or any other event (whether or not the fault of Grantor) that results in the termination of Grantor's leasehold rights.

Breach of Other Agreement. Any breach by Grantor under the terms of any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whether existing now or later.

insecurity. If Lender in good faith deems itself insecure.

Events Affecting Guarantors. Any of the preceding events occur with respect to any guarantor of any of the indebtedness or such guarantor dies or becomes incompetent, unless the obligations arising under the guaranty and related agreements have been unconditionally assumed by the guarantor's estate in a manner satisfactory to Lender.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any event of default and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Lender may exercise any one of more of the following rights and remedies; in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Washington Uniform Commercial Code.

Foreclosure. With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by notice and sale, and Lender shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

Collect Income. Lender shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Income, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the Indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Lender. If the Income is collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevocably designates Lender as Grantor's attorney in fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Appoint Receiver. Lender shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding fore-losure or sale, and to collect the Income from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership against the indebtedness. The receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the Indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.

Tenancy at Sufferance, if Grantor remains in possession of the Property after the Property is sold as provided above or Lender otherwise becomes entitled to possession of the Property upon default of Grantor, Grantor shall become a tenant at sufferance of Lender or the purchaser of the Property and shall, at the election of Lender, either (a) pay a reasonable rental for the Property as requested in the sole discretion of Lender, or (b) vacate the property immediately upon the demand of Lender.

Other Remedies. Trustee or Lender shall have any other right or remedy provided in this Deed of Trust, the Note, or by Washington law or other applicable law.

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all rights to have the Property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, the Trustee or Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Sale. Lender shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Unless otherwise provided by applicable law, reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least 10 days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Walver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Deed of Trust after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Deed of Trust.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall boar interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the Note rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorney fees whether or not there is a lawsuit, including attorneys' fees for bankrupky proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, appraisal fees, title insurance, and fees for the Trustee, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Borrower also will pay any court costs, in addition to all other sums provided by law.

Rights of Trustee, Trustee shall have all of the rights and duties of Lender, as set forth in this section.

POWER AND OBLIGATIONS OF TRUSTEE.

Power of Trustee. In addition to all powers of Trustee arising as a matter of law or under this Deed of Trust, Trustee shall have the power to take the following actions with respect to the Property upon the request of Lender and Grantor: (a) join in preparing and filing a map or plat of the Real Property, including the dedication of streets or other rights in the public; (b) join in granting any essement or creating any restriction on the Real Property; and (c) join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this Deed of Trust or the interest of Lender under this Deed of Trust.

Obligations to Notify. Trustee shall not be obligated to notify any other party of a pending sale under this or any other trust deed or lien, of any action or proceeding in which Grantor, Lender, or Trustee shall be a party, unless the action or proceeding is brought by Trustee.

Trustee. Trustee shall meet all qualifications required for Trustee under applicable state law. In addition to the rights and remedies set forth above, with respect to all or any part of the Froperty, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by notice and sale, and Lender shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

Substitute Trustee. Lender, at Lender's option, may from time to time appoint a successor trustee to any Trustee appointed hereunder by an instrument executed and acknowledged by Lender and recorded in the office of the recorder of SKAMANIA County, Washington. The instrument shall contain, in addition to all other matters required by state law, the name of the original Lender, Trustee, and Grantor, the book and page where this Deed of Trust is recorded, and the name and address of the successor trustee. The successor trustee, without conveyance of the Property, shall succeed to all the title, power, rights, and duties conferred upon the Trustee in this Deed of Trust and by applicable law. This procedure for substitution of trustee shall govern to the exclusion of all other provisions for substitution.

NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this Deed of Trust, including without limitation any Notice of Default and any Notice of Sale to Grantor, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if maled, shall be deemed effective on the third day after being deposited as registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses shown near the top of the first page of this Deed of Trust. Any party may change its address for notices by written notice to the other parties. Lender requests that copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has priority over this Deed of Trust be sent to Lender's address, as shown near the top of the first page of this Deed of Trust. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep Lender and Trustee informed at all times of Grantor's current address.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following provisions are a part of this Deed of Trust:

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Deed of Trust on transfer of Grantor's Interest, and subject to any provisions of applicable law with respect to successor trustees, this Deed of Trust shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns. If ownership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Grantor, Lender, without notice to Grantor, may deal with Grantor's successors with reference to this Deed of Trust and the Indebtedness by way of forbearance or extension without releasing Grantor from the obligations of this Deed of Trust or liability under the Indebtedness.

Applicable Law. This Deed of Trust has been delivered to Lender in the State of Washington. The law of that state shall be applicable for the purpose of construing and determining the validity of this Deed of Trust and, to the fullest extent permitted by the law of any state in which any of the Property is located, determining the rights and remedies of Lender on default. The law of the State of Washington shall control whether the Property may be sold without judicial foreclosure.

Time of Essence. Time is of the essence of this Deed of Trust.

Walver of Homestead Exemption. Granter hereby waives and releases the benefit of the homestead exemption as to all Indebtedness secured by this Deed of Trust.

Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Deed of Trust with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Amendment. No alteration or amendment of this Deed of Trust or the Note shall be effective unless in writing and signed by the parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Deed of Trust are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Deed of Trust.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have waived any rights under this Deed of Trust (or under the Related Do unless such waiver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Deed of Trust, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.

Saverability. The unenforceability of invalidity of any provision or provisions of this Deed of Trust as to any persons or circumstances shall not render that provision or those provisions unenforceable or invalid as to any other persons or circumstances, and all provisions of this Deed of Trust, in all other respects, shall remain valid and enforceable.

Multiple Parties. If Grantor (including any and all Borrowers executing this Deed of Trust) consists of more than one person or entity, all obligations of Grantor under this Deed of Trust shall be joint and several, and all references to Grantor shall mean each and every Grantor.
