NOTICE OF LIEN

GREG WINEBARGER and DON WEBER, Claimants vs DOUG YARNELL, BROUGHTON
LUMBER COMPANY and SDS LUMBER COMPANY

Notice is hereby given that Greg Winebarger and Don Weber of Klickitat County, state of Washington, claim a lien upon rafts and loads of logs, being about 853,000 board feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania and Klickitat Counties, state of Washington, are marked to buyer, and are now lying in the Columbia River, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in hauling said logs; that the names of the owners or reputed owners are Broughton Lumber Company and SDS Lumber Company; that Don Yarnell employed said claimants to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said Doug Yarnell and Broughton Lumber Co. and SDS Lumber Co. agreed to pay the said claimants for such labor and assistance in hauling; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said claimants, who performed labor upon and assisted in hauling said logs for the period of 02/21/89 to this date, that our labor and assistance was so performed and rendered upon said logs between the 31st day of February, 1989 and this date; and the rendition of said service has

not ceased and sixty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants' demand for said service is \$9,340.00 for Weber and \$2,072.00 for Winebarger; that no part thereof has been paid except that payments for some earlier loads not included in the above had been made, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$17,412.00 for both claimants, in which amount they claim a lien upon said logs and proceeds. The said claimants also claim a lien on all logs now owned by said respondents of said county to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs herein described.

Notice is hereby given that a large number of subject logs have been determined to be located in a shipment of logs bearing band #3.49 and a further identification #BDF1119 in a raft under consignment through Knappton Company and located at Knappton's tie-off at Fort Rains on the Columbia River. Claim is made against those logs and similarly located logs.
