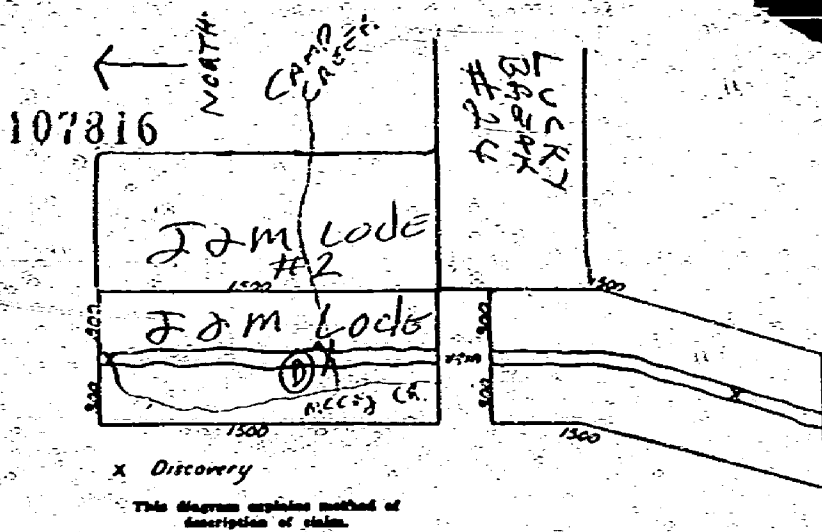




Notice of Mining Location

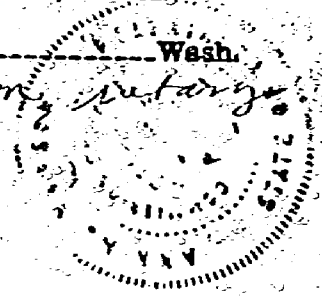
