"This certificate is issued subject to Washington Departments of Fisheries and Wildlife screening criteria as outlined in a Hydraulic Project Approval. Capitol, Olympia, Washington 98504, Attention: Habitat Management Division, Phone (206) 753-3318, to obtain specific requirements for your project."

This authorization to use public waters of the state is classified as a Family Farm Permit in accordance with Chapter 90.66 RCW (Initiative Measure No. 59). This means the land being irrigated under this authorization shall comply with the following definition: Family Farm a geographic area including not more than 2,000 acres of irrigated agricultural lands, whether contiguous or noncontiguous, the controlling interest in which is held by a person having a controling interest in no more than 2,000 acres of irrigated agricultural lands in the State of Washington which are irrigated under water rights acquired after December 8, 1977. Furthermore, the land being irrigated under this authorization must continue to conform to the definition of a family farm.

The Water Resources Act of 1971 specifies certain criteria regarding utilization and management of the waters of the State in the best public interest. Issuance of this certificate was based on sufficient waters available, at least during portions of the year. However, it is pointed out to the certificate holder that his use of the water may be subject to regulation at certain times, based on the necessity to maintain water quantities sufficient for preservation of the natural environment.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390, and 90.44,020.

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
