
We, owners of the above tract of land, hereby declare and certify this Short Plat



TRAVERSE STATEMENT: A closed loop traverse was made with a Pentax PX-10D total station and reflective prisms in good repair. An angular error of 12" (less than 3" per setup) and a distance error of 0.01 ft./2400.24 ft. were balanced by least squares (transit) adjustment and combined for an error of closure of greater than 1:10000.


NARRATIVE: Survey conducted between Jan.24th-Feb.28th, 1990. A closed traverse was made around the parcel, and into control from References 1 and 4. Ties were made to Jessup Road and Ref. 5 was used to verify its location. Two corners were found relative to McCormick road and are noted for information only. The section line fence is off line as shown.
