Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in first class condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall neither conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property or any portion thereof including without imitation removal or alienation by Grantor of the right to remove any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), or gravel or rock products.

2.5 Credit Union's Right to Enter. Credit Union, its agents and representatives, may enter upon the Property at all reasonable times to attend to Credit Union, its agents and to inspect

the Property.

2.6 Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall premptly compty with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Credit Union in writing prior to doing so and Credit Union's interest in the Property is not popardized. Credit Union may require Grantor to post adequate security (reasonably satisfactory to Credit Union) to protect Credit Union's interest.

2.7 Duty of Protect. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those set forth in this section, that from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and reasonable accurity.

2.8 Construction Loan. If some or all of the proceeds of the loan creating the Indebtedness are to be used to construct or complete construction of any Improvement on the Property, the Improvement shall be completed within six moralis from the date of this Deed of Trust and Grantor shall pay in full all costs and expenses in connection with the work.

2.9 Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property has not been and will not be, during the period this deed remains a lien on the Property, used for the creation, manufacture, treatment, storage, of disposal of any hazardous substance, as defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, and other applicable federal and state laws or regulations and amendments. Grantor authorizes Credit Union and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and tests as Credit Union may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this paragraph. Credit Union's inspections and tests shall be for Credit Union's purposes only and shall not be for the benefit or create any duty or liability to Grantor or any third party. Grantor agrees to indemnify and hold Credit Union harmless against any and all claims and losses including afformery fees resulting from a breach of this paragraph, which shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and satisfaction of this Deed of Trust. Taxes and Liens. 3.1 Payment. Grantor shall pay when due before they become delinquent all taxes and assessments levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due alt claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of any liens having priority over or equal to the inferest of Credit Union. under this Deed of Trust, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the prior indebtedness referred to in Section 17, and except as otherwise provided in Subsection 3.2. 3.2 Right to Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a fien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within 15 days after the fien arises or, if a fien is filed, within 15 days after Grantor has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien or deposit with Credit Union, cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Credit Union in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs, attorneys' fees, or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sate under the fien. 3.3 Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Credit Union evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate county official to deliver to Credit Union at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property. 3.4 Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Credit Union at least 15 days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property if a construction lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials, and the cost exceeds \$5,000 (if the Property is used for nonresidential or commercial purposes) or \$1,000 (if the Property is used as a residence). Grantor will on request furnish to Credit Union advance assurances satisfactory to Credit Union that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such Improvements. 3.5 Tex Reserves. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves for payment of taxes and assessments, which reserves shall be created by advance payment or monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least 15 days before due, amounts at least equal to the taxes and assessments to be paid. If 15 days before payment is due the reserve lunds are insufficient, Borrower shall upon demand pay any desciency to Credit Union. The reserve funds shall be held by Credit Union as a general deposit from Borrower and shall constitute a non-interest bearing debt from Credit Union to Borrower, which Credit Union may satisfy by payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Borrower as they become due. Credit Union does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Borrower, and Credit Union is not the agent of Borrower for payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Borrower.

4. Property Damage Insurance. 4.1 Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall produce and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard all-risk extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value basis covering all Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a mortgagee's loss payable clause in favor of Credit Union. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Credit Union. Grantor shall deliver to Credit Union certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of 10 days' written notice to Credit Union.

4.2 Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union of any loss or damage to the Property. Credit Union may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Credit Union may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Credit Union elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Credit Union. Credit Union shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been paid out within 180 days after their receipt and which Credit Union has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used to prepay first accrued interest and then principal of the Indebtedness. If Credit Union holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

4.3 Unexpired Insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Deed of Trust at any trustee's or other sale held under the provision contained within, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property. 4.4 Compliance with Prior Indebtedness. During the period in which any prior Indebtedness described in Section 17 is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such prior Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Deed of Trust to the extent compliance with the terms of this Deed of Trust would constitute a duplication of insurance requirements. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Deed of Trust for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the prior indebtedness. 4.5 Association of Unit Owners. In the event the Real Property has been submitted to unit ownership pursuant to a Unit Ownership Law, or similar law for the establishment of condominiums or cooperative ownership of Real Property, the insurance may be carried by the association of unit owners in Grantor's behalf, and the proceeds of such insurance may be paid to the association of unit owners for the purpose of repairing or record, justing the Property. If not so used by the association, such proceeds shall be paid to Credit Union.

4.6 Insurance Reserves. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves for payment of insurance premiums, which reserves shall be created by monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least 15 days before due, amounts at least equal to the insurance premiums to be paid. If 15 days before payment is due the reserve funds are insufficient, Borrower shall upon demand pay any deficiency to Credit Union. The reserve funds shall be held by Credit Union as a general deposit from Borrower and shall constitute a noninterest bearing debt from Credit Union to Borrower, which Credit Union may satisfy by payment of the insurance premiums required to be paid by Borrower as they become due. Credit Union does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Borrower, and Credit Union is not the agent of Borrower for payment of the insurance premiums required to be paid by Borrower. Expenditure by Credit Union. If Grantor fails to compty with any provision of this Deed of Trust, including the obligation to maintain the prior Indebtedness in good standing as required by Section 17, Credit Union may at its option on Grantor's behalf take the required action and any amount that it expends in so doing shall be added to the Indebtedness. Amounts so added shall be payable on demand with interest from the date of expenditure at the rate the Note bears. The rights provided for in this section shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Credit Union may be entitled on account of the default. Credit Union shall not by taking the required action cure the default so as to bar it from any remedy that it otherwise would have had. Warranty; Defense of Title. 6.1 Title. Grantor warrants that it holds marketable title to the Property in fee simple free of all encumbrances other than those set forth in Section 17 or in any policy of title insurance

issued in fayor of Credit Union in connection with the Deed of Trust. 6.2 Defense of Title. Subject to the exceptions in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title against the fawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Credit Union or Trustee under this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned, Credit Union may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor, Credit Union, or Trustee in connection with the condemnation.

7.2 Proceedings. If any proceedings in condemnation are filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union in writing and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award

Imposition of Tax By State.
 State Taxes Covered. The following shall constitute state taxes to which this section applies:

A specific tax upon trust deeds or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by a trust deed or security agreement.

A specific tax on a Grantor which the taxpayer is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by a trust deed or security agreement.

8.2 Remedies. If any state tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Deed of Trust, this shall have the same effect as a default, and Credit Union exercise any or all of the remedies available to it in the event of a default unless the following conditions are met: Grantor may lawfully pay the lax or charge imposed by the state lax, and

(a) Grantor may and (b) Grantor pays or offers

to pay the tax or charge within 30 days after notice from Credit Union that the tax law has been enacted Power and Obligations of Trustee.

9.1 Powers of Trustee. In addition to all powers of Trustee arising as a matter of law, Trustee shall have the power to take the following actions with respect to the Property upon request of Credit Union and Grantor: (a) Join in preparing and filing a map or plat of the Real Property, including the dedication of streets or other rights in the public

Join in granting any easement or creating any restriction on the Real Property.

Join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this Deed of Trust or the interest of Credit Union under this Deed of Trust.

9.2 Obligations to Notify. Trustee shall not be obligated to notify any other party of a pending sale under any other trust deed or lien, or of any action or proceeding in which Grantor, Credit Union, or Trustee shall be a party, unless the action or proceeding is brought by Trustee. Transfer by Grantor. 10.1 Consent by Credit Union. Grantor shall not transfer or agree to transfer all or part of Grantor's interest in the Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Any

attempt to transfer shall constitute a default under this Deed of Trust

A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of real property or any right, title, or interest therein, whether legal or equitable, whether voluntary or involuntary, by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three years, lease-option contract, or any other method of conveyance of real property interest. If any Borrower is a corporation, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than 25% of the voting stock of Borrower.

If Grantor or prospective transferee applies to Credit Union for consent to a transfer, Credit Union may require such information concerning the prospective transferee as would normally be required from the new loan applicant.

10.2 Condition to Consent. As a condition of its consent to any transfer, Credit Union may in its discretion impose an assumption fee in accordance with Credit Union's fee schedule then in effect, and may increase the interest rate of the Indebtedness to the prevailing rate for similar rates then charged by Credit Union. Credit Union may increase the amount of each remaining installment so that the Indebtedness will be fully paid by the original maturity date. In no event, however, shall the interest rate be increased, nor any fee imposed, beyond the maximum rate permitted under applicable law. This paragraph sets forth terms that Credit Union, at under applicable law. This paragraph sets forth terms that Credit Union, at its sole discretion, may impose additional terms or may decline to consent to a transfer.

10.3 Effect of Consent. If Credit Union consents to one transfer, that consent sh

refleve Granfor of flability for payment of the indebtedness. Following a transfer, Credit Union may agree to any extension of time for payment or modification of the terms of this Deed of Trust or the Note or waive any right or remedy under this Deed of Trust or the Note without relieving Grantor from hability. Grantor waives notice, presentment, and protest with respect to the indebtedness

11. Security Agreement; Financing Statements.

11.1 Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures, and Credit Union shall have all of the rights of a

secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code of the state in which the Real Property is located

11.2 Security Interest. Upon request by Credit Union, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Credit Union to perfect and continue Credit Union's security interest in the Income and Personal Property. Grantor hereby appoints Credit Union as Grantor's attorney in fact for the purpose of executing any documents necessary to perfect or continue this security interest. Credit Union may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file occupies or reproductions of this Deed of Trust as a financing state nent. Grantor will reimburse Credit Union for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property and make it available to Credit Union within three days after receipt of written demand from Credit Union.

11.3 Mobile Homes. If the Property includes mobile homes, motor homes, modular homes, or similar structures, such structures shall be and shall remain Personal Property or Real Property as stated above regardless of whether such structures are affixed to the Real Property, and irrespective of the classification of such structures for the purpose of tax assessments. The removal or addition of axis or wheels, or the placement i pon or removal from a concrete base, shall not after the characterization of such structures.

12. Reconveyance on Full Performance.

If Granior pays all of the Indebtedness when due and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Granior under this Deed of Trust and the Note, Credit Union shall execute and deliver to Trustee a request for full reconveyance and shall execute and deliver to Grantor suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Credit Union's security interest in the Income and the Personal Property. Consequences of Default.

14.1. Remedies. Upon the occurrence of any event of default and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Credit Union may declare a default and exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law

Credit Union shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty Grantor would be required to pay.

(b) With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by notice and sale, and Credit Union shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property. Credit Union shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code in effect

in the state in which the Credit Union is located

(d) Credit Union shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Income, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Credit Union's costs, against the Indebtednees. In furtherance of this right, Credit Union may require any tenant or other user to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Credit Union. If the Income is collected by Credit Union, then Grantor irrevocably designates Credit Union as Grantor's attorney in fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to credit Union in response to Credit Union's demand shall satisfy the obligation for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Credit Union may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

(e) Credit Union shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of any or all of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Income from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Credit Union's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the Indebtedness

by a substantial amount. Employment by Credit Union shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.

(f) If Grantor remains in possession of the Property after the Property is sold as provided above or Credit Union of remains becomes entitled to possession of the Property upon default of Grantor, Grantor shall become a tenant at will of Credit Union or the purchaser of the Property and shall pay while in possession a reasonable rental for use of the Property.

(g) If the Real Property is submitted to unit ownership, Credit Union or its designee may vote on any matter that may come before the members of the association of unit ownership. pursuant to the power of attorney granted Credit Union in Section 16.2

(h) Trustee and Credit Union shall have any other right or remedy provided in this Deed of Trust, or the Note

14.2 Sale of the Property. In exercising its rights and remedies, the Trustee or Credit Union, shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, or to sell certain portions of the Property and refrain from selling other portions. Credit Union shall be entitled to bid at any public sale of all or any portion of the Property.

14.3 Notice of Sale. Credit Union shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten days before the time of the sale or disposition.

14.4 Waiver, Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Credit Union to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Deed of Trust after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Credit Union's right to declare a default and exercise are remedies under this Deed of Trust. its remedies under this Deed of Trust.

14.5 Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Credit Union institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust. Credit Union shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at that and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Credit Union that are necessary at any time in Credit Union's opinion for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the rate of the Note. Expenses covered by this paragraph include (without limitation) all attorney fees incurred by Credit Union whether or not there is a lawsuit, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, appraisal fees, it is insurance, and fees for the Trustee. Attorney fees include those for bankruptcy proceedings and anticipated post-judgment collection actions.

Notice. 15.

Any notice under this Deed of Trust shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective on the second day after being deposited as first-class registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, directed to the address stated in this Deed of Trust. 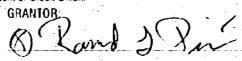
