15 1. RESIDENCE: The last known residential address of petitioner

18 2. MARRIAGE: The parties were married at Stevenson, Washington
on August 2, 1974.

3. SEPARATION: The parties separated on January 1, 1982.

4. NECESSITY: The marriage is irretrievably broken and should

8. ATTORNEY FEES: Petitioner is without sufficient funds to pay all her attorney fees and court costs incurred in this action, and requests that respondent be ordered to pay \$270.00 if this matter is uncontested, and one-half of her fees and costs if this matter is contested in any way.





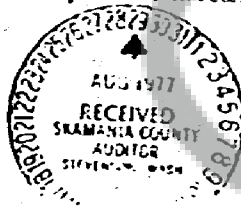
