MOORE and LUCILLE M. MOORE, husband and wife, as to an undivided one-half interest, as joint tenants with rights of survivorship and not as tenants in common; and, MICHAEL L. NEAL and ANNE M. MOORE, husband and wife, as to the remaining undivided one-half interest, as joint tenants with rights of survivorship and not as tenants in common, the following real estate situate in Skamania County, Washington:

That portion of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 20, Township 3 North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the said Section 20; thence West along the South line of the said Section 490.9 feet; thence North parallel to the East line of the said Section to intersection with the Southerly right of way line of the County Road known and designated as the Cook-Underwood Road; thence North 81° 39' East following the Southerly right of way line of said road 500 feet, more or less, to intersection with the East line of the said Section 20; thence South along the East line of said Section 1,075 feet, more or less, to the Point of Beginning; EXCEPT the West 125 feet thereof.
