Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

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If any person lable to pay any tax respects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the arrown (including any interest, additional amount, addition) to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs their may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a fen in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

: Unless another data is specifically fixed by line, the field imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such Kabity) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.
