Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

()

If any person hards to pay any tax neglects or refuse to us, the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, politional amount, addition to tax, or assessable persity, spetter with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a Een in favor of the United States upon all property and of their to personal whether and of property. and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien-Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the hability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the targains arising out of such hability) is satisfied or becomes unerdinged. able by reason of tapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—Tre len impos-ed by section 632f shall not be valid as against any purchas-er, holder of a security interest, mechanic's fenor, or judg-ment tien creditor until notice thereof which meets the require-ments of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.-
