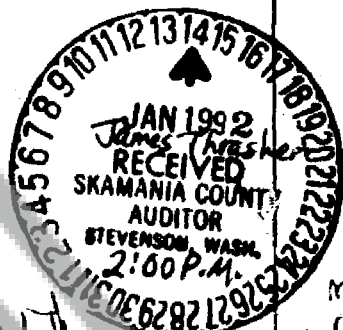

6. SEPARATE PROPERTY AND DEBTS

From and after March 28, 1991, the date of separation, any and all property acquired by either of the parties shall be his or her separate property and estate and the other shall have no interest therein. Each party shall be required to pay and be responsible for all indebtedness incurred by him or her from and after March 28, 1991, the date of separation.
