2.6 Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all faws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Credit Union in writing prior to doing so and Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized.

2.7 Outly of Protect. Grantor may do all other acts, allowed by law, that from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the security.

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2.8 Construction Loan. If some or all of the proceeds of the loan creating the Indebtedness are to be used to construct or complete construction of any Improvement on the Property the Improvement shall be completed within six months from the date of this Deed of Trust and Grantor shall pay in full all costs and expenses in connection with the work.

2.9 Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property has not been and will not be, during the period this deed remains a tien on the Property, used for the creation, manufacture, treatment, styrage, or disposal of any hazardous substance, as defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response. Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, and other applicable federal and state laws or regulations and amendments. Grantor authorizes Credit Union and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and tests as Credit Union may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this paragraph. Credit Union's inspections and tests shall be for Gredit Union's purposes only and shall not be for the benefit or create any duty or liability to Grantor or any third party. Grantor agrees to indemnify and hold Credit Union harmless against any and all claims and losses including attorney fees resulting from a breach of this paragraph, which shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and satisfaction of this Deed of Trust

3. Taxes and Liens.

3.1 Payment, Grantor shall pay when due before they become delinquent all taires and assessments levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of any liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Credit Union under this Deed of Trust, except for the lien of taixes and assessments not due, except for the prior indebtedness referred to in Section 17, and except as otherwise provided in Subsection 3.2.

3.2. Right to Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within 15 days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within 15 days after Grantor has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the filen or deposit with Credit Union, cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Credit Union in an amount sufficient to discharge the tien plus any costs, afforneys fees, or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien 3.3 Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Credit Union evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and chall authorize the appropriate country official to

deliver to Credit Union at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

3.4. Notice of Construction, Grantor shall notify Credit Union at least 15 days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property if a construction lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials, and the cost exceeds \$5,000 (if the Property is used for nonresidential or commercial purposes) or \$1,000 (if the Property is used as a residence). Grantor will on request furnish to Credit Union advance assurances satisfactory to Credit Union; that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such Improvements

3.5 Tax Reserves. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves for payment of taxes and assessments, which reserves shall be created by advance payment or monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least 15 days before due, amounts at least equal to the taxes and assessments to be paid. If 15 days before payment is due the reserve funds are insufficient, Borrower shall upon demand pay any deficiency to Credit Union. The reserve funds shall be held by Credit Union as a general deposit from Borrower and shall constitute a non-interest bearing debt from Credit Union to Borrower, which Credit Union may satisfy by payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Borrower as they become due. Credit Union does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Borrower, and Credit Union is not the agent of Borrower for payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Borrower

4. Property Damage Insurance.

4.1 Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard alt-risk extended coverage endorsements on a repfacement basis for the full insurable value basis covering all Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a mortgagee's loss payable clause. in favor of Credit Union. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Credit Union. Grantor shall deliver to Credit Union certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a miniform of 10 days. Aritten notice to Credit Union,

4.2 Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify noted Union of any loss or damage to the Property. Credit Union may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within 15 days of the casualty. Credit Union may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indeptedness or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Credit Union elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Credit Union, Credit Union shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or restributise Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been paid out within 180 days after their receipt and which Credit Union has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used to prepay first accrued interest and then

principal of the Indebtedness of Credit Union holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor
4.3 Unexpired Insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall insure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Deed of Trust at any trustee's or other sale held under the provision contained within, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

4.4 Compliance with Prior Indebtedness. During the period in which any prior Indebtedness described in Section 17 is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such prior Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Deed of Trust to the extent compliance with the terms of this Deed of Trust would constitute a duplication of insurance requirements. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Deed of Trust for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the prior Indebtedness.

4.5 Association of Unit Owners. In the event the Real Property has been submitted to unit ownership pursuant to a Unit Ownership Law, or similar law for the establishment of condominiums or cooperative ownership of Real Property, the insurance may be carried by the association of unit owners in Granton's behalf, and the proceeds of such insurance may be paid to the association of unit owners for the purpose of repairing or reconstructing the Property. If not so used by the association, such proceeds shalf be paid to Credit Union

4.6 Insurance Reserves. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves for payment of insurance premiums, which reserves shall be created by monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least 15 days before due, amounts at least equal to the insurance premiums to be paid, it 15 days before payment is due the reserve funds are insufficient. Borrower shall upon demand pay any deficiency to Credit Union. The reserve funds shall be held by Credit Union as a general deposit from Borrower and shall constitute a noninterest bearing debt from Credit Union to Borrower, which Credit Union may salisfy by payment of the insurance premiums required to be paid by Borrower as they become due. Credit Union does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Borrower, and Credit Union is not the agent of Borrower for payment of the insurance premiums required to be paid by Borrower

5. Expenditure by Credit Union.

If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Deed of Trust, including the obligation to maintain the prior Indebtedness in good standing as required by Section 17. Credit Union may at its option on Grantor's behalf pay amounts to cure any default in the prior indebtedness and any amount that it expends in so doing shall be added to the Indebtedness. Amounts so added shall be payable in accordance with the terms of the indebtedness. The rights provided for in this section shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Credit Union may be entitled on account of the default. Credit Union shall not by taking the required action cure the default so as to bar it from any remedy that it otherwise would have had

Warranty; Defense of Title.

6.1 Title. Grantor warrants that it holds marketable title to the Property in fee simple free of all encumbrances other than those set forth in Section 17 or in any policy of litle insurance issued in favor of Credit Union in connection with the Deed of Trust

6.2 Defense of Title. Subject to the exceptions in the paragraph above. Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Credit Union or Trustee under this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Condemnation.

7.1 Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned. Credit Union may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and afterneys fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor, Credit Union, or Trustee in connection with the condemnation

7.2 Proceedings. If any proceedings in condemnation are filed. Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union in writing and Grantor shall promptly take such sleps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award

10. Transfer by Grantor.

Imposition of Tax By State.
 State Taxes Covered. The following shall constitute state taxes to which this section applies

A specific tax upon trust deeds or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by a trust deed or security agreement.

A specific tax on a Grantor which the tarpayer is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by a trust deed or security agreement. A tax on a trust deed or security agreement chargeable against the Credit Union or the holder of the Agreement secured.

A specific tax on all for any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by a Grantor.

Power and Obligations of Trustee

9.1 Powers of Trustee. In addition to all powers of Trustee arising as a matter of law, Trustee shall have the power to take the following actions with respect to the Property upon the request of Credit Union and Grantor

(a) Join in preparing and filing a map or plat of the Real Property, including the dedication of streets or other rights in the public

(b) Join in granting any easement or creating any restriction on the Real Property.

(c) Join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this Deed of Trust or the interest of Credit Union under this Deed of Trust

9.2 Obligations to Notify. Trustee shall not be obligated to notify any other party of a pending safe under any other trust deed or lien, or of any action or proceeding in which Grantor, Credit Union, or Trustee shall be a party, unless the action or proceeding is brought by Trustee

10.1 Consent by Credit Union. Grantor shall not transfer or agree to transfer all or part of Grantor's interest in the Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Any attempt to transfer shall entitle the Credit Union to terminate and accelerate the indebtedness under this Deed of Trust.

A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of real property or any right, title, or interest therein, whether legal or equitable, whether voluntary or involuntary, by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three years, lease-option contract, or any other method of conveyance of real property interest. If any Borrower is a corporation, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than 25% of the voting stock of Borrower.

If Grantor or prospective transferse applies to Credit Union for consent to a transfer, Credit Union may require such information concerning the prospective transferse as would normally that the provided that the provided the provided that the pro

10.2 Effect of Consent. If Credit Union consents to one transfer, that consent shall not constitute a consent to other transfers or a waiver of this section. No transfer by Grantor shall relieve Granfor of flability for payment of the Indebtedness. Following a transfer, Credit Union may agree to any extension of time for payment or modification of the terms of this Deed of Trust or the Agreement or waive any right or remedy under this Deed of Trust or the Agreement without relieving Granfor from flability. Granfor waives notice, presentment, and profest with respect to the Indebtedness.

11. Security Agreement; Financing Statements.

11.1 Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures, and Credit Union shall have all of the rights of a

secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code of the state in which the Real Property is located

11.2 Security Interest. Upon request by Credit Union, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Credit Union to perfect and continue Credit Union's security interest in the Income and Personal Property. Grantor hereby appoints Credit Union as Grantor's attorney in fact for the purpose of executing any documents necessary to perfect or continue this security interest. Credit Union may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file occupies or reproductions of this Deed of Trust as a financing statement. Grantor will reimburse Credit Union for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property and make it available to Credit Union within three days after receipt of written demand from Credit Union

11.3 Mobile Homes. If the Property includes mobile homes, motor homes, Property as stated above regardless of whether such structures are affixed to the Real Property, and irrespective of the classification of such structures for the purpose of tax assessments. The removal or addition of axles or wheels, or the placement upon or removal from a concrete base, shall not after the characterization of such structures

12. Reconveyance on Full Performance.

It Grantor pays all of the Indebtedness when due and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Deed of Trust and the Agreement, Credit Union shall execute and deliver to Trustee a request for full reconveyance and shall execute and deliver to Grantor suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Credit Union's security interest in the Income and the Personal Property. Any reconveyance fee or termination fee required by law shall be paid by Granton.

13. Possible Actions of Credit Union.

The Credit Union may take the following actions with respect to your Agreement under the circumstances listed below

Termination and Acceleration. The Credit Union may terminate your Agreement and require Grantor to pay the entire outstanding balance immediately, and charge Grantor certain fees it any of the following happen (1) Grantor engages in any fraud or material misrepresentation in connection with the Agraement. For example, if there are false statements or omissions on Grantor's

application or financial statements (2) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the Agreement

(3) Grantor's actions or inactions adversely affect the collateral or Credit Union's rights in the collateral. For example, if Grantor fails to maintain insurance, pay taxes; transfer title to or sell the collateral, prevent the foreclosure of any items, or waste of the collateral

Suspension of Credit/Reduction of Credit Limit. Credit Union may refuse to make additional advances on the line of credit or reduce the credit limit during any period in which the following exist or occur.

(1) Any of the circumstances fisted in a labove.

During the period in which any prior Indebtedness described in Section 17 is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such prior Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Deed of Trust to the extent compliance with the terms of this Deed of Trust would constitute a duplication of insurance requirements if any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Deed of Trust for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the prior Indebtedness.

45 Association of Unit Owners. In the event the Real Property has been submitted to unit ownership pursuant to a Unit Ownership Law, or similar law for the establishment of condominiums or cooperative ownership of Real Property, the insurance may be carried by the association of unit owners in Granton's behalf, and the proceeds of such insurance may be

paid to the association of unit owners for the purpose of repairing or reconstructing the Property. If not so used by the association, such proceeds shall be paid to Credit Union.

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Expenditure by Credit Union.

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Warranty; Defense of Title.

to defend the action and obtain the award

6.1 Title. Grantor warrants that it holds marketable title to the Property in fee simple free of all encumbrances other than those set forth in Section 17 or in any policy of title insurance issued in favor of Credit Union in connection with the Deed of Trust 62 Defense of Title. Subject to the exceptions in the paragraph above, Granfor warrants and will forever defend the title against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any

action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Credit Union or Trustee unider this Deed of Trust, Grantor's half defend the action at Grantor's expense Condemnation.

7.1. Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned. Credit Union may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable rosts, expenses, and attorneys fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor, Credit Union, or Trustee in connection with the condemnation. 7.2 Proceedings. If any proceedings in condemnation are filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union in writing and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary

Imposition of Tax By State.
 State Taxes Covered. The following shall constitute state taxes to which this section applies

(a) A specific tax upon trust deeds or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by a trust deed or security agreement.

(b) A specific tax on a Grantor which the tax payer is authorized or required to dealer them.

A specific lax on a Grantor which the tainpayer is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by a trust deed or security agreement. A tax on a trust deed or security agreement chargeable against the Credit Union or the holder of the Agreement secured. A specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by a Grantor. (c)

**Power and Obligations of Trustee** 

9.1 Powers of Trustee. In addition to all powers of Trustee arising as a matter of law. Trustee shall have the power to take the following actions with respect to time Property upon the request of Credit Union and Grantor

(a) Join in preparing and filing a map or plat of the Real Property, including the dedication of streets or other rights in the public

(b) Join in granting any easement or creating any restriction on the Real Property
(c) Join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this Deed of Trust or the interest of Credit Union under this Deed of Trust

9.2 Obligations to Notify. Trustee shall not be obligated to notify any other party of a pending safe under any other trust deed or lien, or of any action or proceeding in which Grantor,

Credit Union, or Trustee shall be a party, unless the action or proceeding is brought by Trustee Transfer by Grantor.

10.1 Consent by Credit Union. Grantor shall not transfer or agree to transfer all or part of Grantor's interest in the Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Any attempt to transfer shall entitle the Credit Union to terminate and accelerate the indebtedness under this Deed of Trust

A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of real property or any right, title, or interest therein, whether legal or equitable, whether voluntary or involuntary, by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three years lease option contract or any other method of conveyance of real property interest. If any Borrower is a corporation, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than 25°s of the voting stock of Borrower.

If Grantor or prospective transferee applies to Credit Union for consent to a transfer, Credit Union may require such information concerning the prospective transferee as would normally

quired from the new loan applicant

10.2 Effect of Consent. if Credit Union consents to one transfer, that consent shall not constitute a consent to other transfers or a waiver of this section. No transfer by Grantor shall refleve Grantor of hability for payment of the Indebtedness. Following a transfer, Credit Union may agree to any extension of time for payment or modification of the terms of this Deed of Trust or the Agreement or waive any right or remedy under this Deed of Trust or the Agreement without reflexing Grantor from hability. Grantor waives notice, presentment, and protest with respect to the indebtedness

Security Agreement; Financing Statements.

11.1 Security Agreement. This institute at security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures, and Credit Union shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code of the state in which the Real Property is located.

11.2 Security Interest. Upon request by Credit Union, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Credit Union to perfect and continue Credit Union's security interest in the Income and Personal Property. Grantur hereby appoints Credit Union as Grantor's attorney in fact for the purpose of executing any documents necessary to perfect or continue this security interest. Credit Union may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file occupies or reproductions of this Deed of Trust as a financing stement. Grantor will reimburse Credit Union for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default. Grantor shall assemble the Personal Procedu It available to Credit Union within three days after receipt of written demand from Credit Union.

11.3 Mcbite Homes. If the Property includes mobile homes, motor homes, modular homes, or similar structures, such structures shall be and shall remain Personal Property or Real

Property as stated above regardless of whether such structures are affixed to the Real Property, and irrespective of the classification of such structures for the purpose of tax assessments The removal or addition of axles or wheels, or the placement upon or removal from a concrete base, shall not after the characterization of such structures.

12. Reconveyance on Full Performance.

if Grantor pays all of the Indebtedness when due and otherwise performs affitine obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Deed of Trust and the Agreement, Credit Union shall execute and deliver to Trustee a request for full reconveyance and shall execute and deliver to Grantor suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on the evidencing Credit Union's security interest in the Income and the Personal Property. Any reconveyance fee or termination fee required by taw shall be paid by Granfor Possible Actions of Credit Union.

The Credit Union may take the following actions with respect to your Agreement under the circumstances listed below.

Termination and Acceleration. The Credit Union may terminate your Agreement and require Grantor to pay the entire outstanding balance immediately, and charge Grantor. certain fees if any of the following happen (1) Grantor engages in any fraud or material misrepresentation in connection with the Agreement. For example, if there are false statements or orbissions on Grantor's

application or financial statements (2) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the Agreement

(3) Grantor's actions or inactions adversely affect the collateral or Credit Union's rights in the collateral. For example, if Grantor fails to imaintain insurance, pay taxes, transfer title to or self the collateral, prevent the forecosure of any items, or waste of the collateral business on the line of credit reduce the credit Limit. Credit Union may refuse to make additional advances on the line of credit or reduce the credit limit during any period in

which the following exist or occur (1) Any of the circumstances listed in all, above
