If any person Eable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or seesesable penalty. together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the Sen imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the fability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxosyst amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayor arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unanticoable by reason of lapus of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. —The Sen Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchase, or, holder of a security interest, mechanic's fanor, or judg-ment fan creditor until notice thereof which meets the require-ments of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary.
