3.5 Tax F wes. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves for payment of taxes and assessments, which reserves shall be created by advance payment or monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least 15 days before due, amounts at least equal to the taxes and assessments to be paid. If 15 days before payment is due the reserve funds are insufficient, Borrower shall upon demand pay any deficiency to Credit Union. The reserve funds shall be held by Credit Union as a general deposit from Borrower and shall constitute a non-inferest bearing debt from Credit Union to Borrower, which Credit Union may satisfy by payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Borrower as they become due. Credit Union does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Borrower, and Credit Union is not the agent of Borrower for payment of the tax as and assessments required to be paid by Borrower.

4.1 Meintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard all-risk extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value basis covering all Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a mortgagee's loss payable clause in favor of Credit Union. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Credit Union. Grantor shall deliver to Credit Union.

4.2 Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union of any loss or damage to the Property. Credit Union may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Credit Union elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair of the Property. Grantor shall promptly notify credit Union of the Indebtedness or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Credit Union elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Credit Union. Credit Union shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburses Grantor from the proceeds for the restoration of Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been paid out within 180 days after their receipt and which Credit Union has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used to prepay first accrued interest and then principal of the Indebtedness. 4.3 Unexpired insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Deed of Trust at any trustee's or

other sale held under the provision contained within, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

4.4 Compliance with Prior Indebtedness. During the period in which any prior Indebtedness described in Section 17 is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such prior Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Deed of Trust to the extent compliance with the terms of this Deed of Trust would constitute a duplication of insurance requirements. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Deed of Trust for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the prior Indebledness.

4.5 Association of Unit Owners. In the event the Real Property has been submitted to unit ownership pursuant to a Unit Ownership Law, or similar taw for the establishment of condominiums or cooperative ownership of Real Property, the hisurance may be carried by the association of unit owners in Granton's behalf, and the proceeds of such insurance may be

paid to the association of unit owners for the purpose of repairing or reconstructing the Property. If not so used by the association, such proceeds shall be paid to Credit Union.

4.6 Insurance Reserves. Subject to any irritations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves for payment of insurance premiums, which reserves shall be created by monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least 15 days before due, amounts at least equal to the insurance premiums to be paid. If 15 days before payment is due the reserve funds are insufficient, Borrower shall upon derivand pay any deficiency to Credit Union. The reserve funds shall be held by Credit Union as a general deposit from Corrower and shall constitute a noninterest bearing debt from Credit Union to Borrower, which Credit Union may satisfy by payment of the insurance miums required to be paid by Borrower as they become due. Credit Union does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Borrower, and Credit Union is not the agent of Borrower for payment of the insurance premiums required to be paid by Borrower.

is If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Deed of Trust, including the obligation to maintain the prior Indebtedness in good standing as required by Section 17, Credit Union may at its option on Grantor's behalf pay amounts to cure any default in the prior indebtedness and any amount that it expends in so doing shall be added to the Ind-obtedness. Amounts so added shall be payable in accordance with the terms of the indebtedness. The rights provided for in this section shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Credit on may be entitled on account of the default. Credit Union shall not by taking the required action cure the default so as to bar it from any remedy that a otherwise would have had.

Warranty; Defence of Title

6.1 Title. Grantor warrants that a holds marketable title to the Property in fee simple free of all encumbrances other than those set forth in Section 17 or in any policy of title insurance red in favor of Credit Union in connection with the Deed of Trust. 6.2 Determe of Title. Subject to the exceptions in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the life against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's tate or the interest of Credit Union or Trustee under this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense.

7.1 Application of Not Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned, Credit Union may at its election require that all or any part of the net proce ed to the Indebtedness. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and altorneys' fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor, Credit Union, or Trustee in connection with the condemnation.

7.2 Proceedings. If any proceedings in condemnation are filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Credit Union in writing and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necested the action and obtain the award.

9.2 Òb itions to Netify. Trustee shall not be obligated to notify any other party of a pending sale under any other trust deed or lien, or of any action or proceeding in which Grantor,

Credit Union, or Trustee shall be a party, unless the action or proceeding is brought by Trustee.

A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of real property or any right, title, or interest therein, whether legal or equitable, whether voluntary or involuntary, by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three years, lease-option contract, or any other method of conveyance of real property interest. If any Borrower is a corporation, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than 25% of the voting stock of Borrower.

If Grantor or prospective transferee applies to Credit Union for consent to a transfer, Credit Union may require such information concerning the prospective transferee as would normally be required from the new loan applicant.

10.2 Effect of Consent. If Credit Union consents to one transfer, that consent shall not consent to other transfers or a waiver of this section. No transfer by Grantor shall ve Grantor of hability for payment of the Indebtedness. Following a transfer, Credit Union may agree to any extension of time for payment or modification of the terms of this Deed of Trust or th nt or v e arry night or a respect to the injebted

- (a) With respect to all or any part of the Real Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by notice and sale, and Credit Union shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law
- (b) With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Credit Union shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code in effect in the state in which the Credit Union is located

In furtherance of this right, Credit Union may require any tenant or other user to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Credit Union. If the Income is collected by Credit Union, then Grantor irrevocubly designates Credit Union as Grantor's attorney in fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to credit Union in response to Credit Union's demand shall satisfy the obligation for which the payment's are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Credit Union may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.
- (d) Credit Union shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of any or all of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Income from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness, The receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Credit Union's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the Indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Credit Union shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.
- (e) It Grantor remains in possession of the Property after the Property is sold as provided above or Credit Union otherwise becomes entitled to possess on of the Property upon default of Grantor, Grantor shall become a tenant at will of Credit Union or the purchaser of the Property and shall pay white in possession a reasonable rental for use of the Property.

Credit Union shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten days before the time of the sale or disposition.
- 14.4 Walver, Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Credit Union to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Deed of Trust after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Credit Union's right to take actions on the indebtedness and exercise its remedies under this Deed of Trust.
- 14.5 Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Credit Union institute's any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust, Credit Union shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Credit Union that are necessary at any time in Credit Union's opinion for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the rate of the Agreement. Expenses covered by this paragraph include (without limitation) all attorney fees incurred by Credit Union whether or not there is a tawsuit, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, appraisal fees, title insurance, and fees for the Trustee. Attorney fees include those for bankruptcy proceedings and anticipated post-judgment collection actions.
 - 15. Notice

Any notice under this Deed of Trust shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective on the second day after being deposited as first-class registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, directed to the address stated in this Deed of Trust. Unless otherwise required by applicable law, any party may change its address for notices by written notice to the other parties. Credit Union requests that copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has priority over this Deed of Trust be sent to Credit Union's address, as set forth on page one of this Deed of Trust. If the Property is in California, the notice shall be as provide by Section 2924b of the Chil Code of California. If this property is in Viginia, the following notice applies. NOTICE -- THE DEBT SECURED HEREBY IS SUBJECT TO CALL IN FULL OR THE TERMS THEREOF MODIFIED IN THE EVENT OF SALE OR CONVEYANCE OF THE PROPERTY CONVEYED.

- 16. Mecellaneous.
- 12 16.1 Successors and Assigns. Subject to the Emitations stated in this Deed of Trust on transfer of Granton's interest, and subject to the provisions of applicable law with respect to successor trustees, this Deed of Trust shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns.
- 16.2 Unit Ownership Power of Attorney. If the Peat Property is submitted to unit ownership, Grantor grants an argueocable power of attorney to Credit Union to vote in its discretion on any matter that may come before the members of the association of unit owners. Credit Union shall have the right to exercise this power of attorney only after default by Grantor and may decline to exercise this power, as Credit Union may see fit.
- 16.5 Annual Reports. If the Property is used for purposes other than grantor's residence, within 60 days following the close of each fiscal year of Grantor, Grantor shall furnish to Credit Union a statement of net operating income received from the Property during Grantor's previous fiscal year in such detail as Credit Union shall require. "Net operating income" shall mean all cash receipts from the Property less all cash expenditures made in connection with the operation of the Property.
- 16.4 Applicable Law. The law of the state in which the Property is focated shall be applicable for the purpose of construing and determining the validity of this Deed of Trust and determining the rights and remedies of Credit Union on default.
 - 16.5 Joint and Several Liabitity. If Granfor consists of more than one person or entity, the obligations imposed upon Granfor under this Deed of Trust shall be joint and several.
 - 16.6 Time of Ecounce. Time is of the essence of this Deed of Trust.
 - 16.7 Use.
 - (a) If located in Idaho, the Property either is not more than twenty acres in area or is located within an incorporated city or village.
 - (b) If located in Washington, the Property is not used principally for agricultural or farming purposes.
 - (c) If located in Montana, the Property does not exceed fifteen acres and this instrument is a Trust Indenture executed in conformity with the Small Tract Financing Act of Montana
 - (d) If located in Utah, this instrument is a Trust Deed executed in conformity with the Utah Trust Deed Act. UCA 57-1-19 et seq.
 - 16.8 Walver of Homesteed Exemption. Borrower hereby waives the benefit of the homestead exemption as to all sums secured by this Deed of Trust.
- 16.9 Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Deed of Trust with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Credit Union in any capacity, without the written consent of Credit Union.
- 16.10 Substitute Trustèle. Credit Union, at Credit Union's option, may from time to time appoint a successor trustee to any Trustee appointed hereunder by an instrument executed and acknowledged by Credit Union and recorded in the office of the Recorder of the county where the Property is located. The instrument shall contain the name of the original Credit Union, Trustee, and Borrower, the book and page where this Deed of Trust is recorded, and the name and address of the successor trustee. The successor trustee shall, without conveyance of the Property, succeed to all the tatie, powers, and duties conferred upon the Trustee herein and by applicable law. This procedure for substitution of trustee shall govern to the exclusion of all other provisions for substitution.
- 16.11 Statement of Ooligation. If the Property is in California, Credit Union may collect a fee not to exceed \$50 for furnishing the statement of obligation as provided by Section 2943 of the Civil Code of California
- 16.12 Severability. If any provision in this Deed of Trust shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the validity and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired.
 - 17. Prior Indebtedness.
 - 17.1 Prior Lien. The lien securing the indebtedness secured by this Deed of Trust is and remains secondary and inferior to the lien securing payment of a prior obligation in the form of a:

17.3 No Modifications. Grantor shall not enter into any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement which has priority over this Deed of Trust by which that agreement is modified, amended, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Grantor shall neither request nor accept any future advances under a prior mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement without the prior written consent of Credit Union.
