Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may acouse in addition thereto; shall be a lien in tevor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether read or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 8321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforce-able by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The Sen Imposwww.grrrent arrest Vrwatturi 8, "In the Impo-ed by section 6321 shall not be velid as against any purchas-er, holder of a security interest, mechanic's fishor, or judg-ment lien creditor until notice thereof which mess the require-ments of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.
