Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(1) General Rule. - United notice of hen in raff ed in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refer period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (i) when the expiration of such refling period.

(2) Place For Filing . -- A notice of Sen reflied during the required reliting period whalf be effective only-

> () such notice of Sen is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(i) in the case of real property, and the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refling of notice of Sen under subparagraph (A). (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien .— Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue fair not later than 30 days after the day

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Se cretary finds that the Sability for the amount assessed, togeth-er with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(4) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.-

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes established written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.

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
