DEED OF TRUST

THIS DEED OF TRUST IS DATED JULY 10, 1992, among DEBORAH SULLIVAN and ROGER HAVEN, wife and husband, whose mailing address is 229 EVERGREEN DRIVE BOX 170, NORTH BONNEVILLE, WA 98639 (referred to below as "Grantor"); Northwest National Bank, whose mailing address is 1607 Main Street, P.O. Box 1867, Vancouver, WA 98668 (referred to below sometimes as "Lender" and sometimes as "Beneficiary"); and Charles E. Gallup, whose mailing address is 515 W. 15th Street, Vancouver, WA 98660 (referred to below as "Trustee").

CONVEYANCE AND GRANT. For valuable consideration, Grantor conveys to Trustee in trust with power of sale, rigits of entry and possession and for the benefit of Londor as Beneficiary, at of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently exected or allhed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all essentents, rights of way, and appurtaneous; all water rights and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with citch or impalion rights); and all other rights, rowalise, and profits relating to the real property, including without irritation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in SKANLAMA County, State of Washington (the "Real Property"):



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The Real Property or its address is commonly known as OFF EVERGREEN DRIVE, NORTH BONNEVILLE, WA 98639. The Real Property tex identification number is 2-7-20-1100.

Grantor hereby steligns as security to Lender, all of Granton's right, title, and interest in and to all seases, Rents, and profits of the Property. This assignment is recorded in accordance with RCW 65.06.070; the line created by this assignment is intended to be specific, perfected and chosts upon the recording of this Deed of Trust. Lender grants to Granton's license to collect the Rents and profits, which license may be revoked at Lender's option and shall be automatically revoked upon acceleration of all or part of the Indebtschoes.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Deed of Trust. Terms not otherwise defined in this Deed of Trust shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lewful money of the United States of America.

Burefictury. The word "Beneficiery" means Northwest National Bank, its successors and assigns. Northwest National Bank also is referred to as "Lander" in this Deed of Trust.

Deed of Trust. The words "Deed of Trust" mean this Deed of Trust among Grantor, Lander, and Trustee, and Includes without firrienton all assignment and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Greater. The word "Granton" means any and all persons and entities emousing this Deed of Trust, including without limitation DEBORAH SULLIVAN and ROGER HAVEN.

Guaranter. The word "Guarantor" means and includes without limitation, any and all guarantors, sureties, and accommodation parties in connection with the industrialness.

httprovements. The word "Improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, tixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes allived on the Real Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtodies. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amorphis expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Granter or expenses incurred by Trustee or Lender to enforce obligations of Granter under this Deed of Trust. In addition to the Note, the word "Indebtedness" includes all obligations, debts and liabilities, plus interest thereon, of Granter or any one or more of their, whether arising now or later, whether related or unrelated to the purpose of the Note, whether voluntary or otherwise, whether obligated as guaranter or otherwise, and whether Granter may be or hereafter may become otherwise unanterceable. Specifically, without fimilation, this Deed of Trust secures a revolving line of order, with a variable rate of interest, which obligates Lender to make advances. The unput between of the revolving line of credit may at certain times be lower than the amount shown or zero. A zero balance does not terminate the line of credit or terminate Lender's obligation to advance funds to Granter. Therefore, the list of this Deed of Trust will remain in full force and effect notwithstanding any zero balance.

Lender. The word "Lander" means Northwest National Bank, its successors and assigns.

Note. The word "Note" means the Note dated July 10, 1992, In the original principal amount of \$20,000.00 from Grantor to Lander, together with all renewels, extensions, modifications, refinancings, and substitutions for the Note. NOTICE TO GRANTOR: THE NOTE CONTAINS A VARIABLE INTEREST RATE.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or afford to the Reel Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all issues and profits thereon and proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Conveyance and Grant" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation all promissory notes, credit agreements, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments, agreements and documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with the indebtedness.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalties, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

Trustee. The word "Trustee" means Charles E. Gallup and any substitute or successor trustees.

THIS DEED OF TRUST, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INCESTECHESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ANY AND ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THE NOTE, THE RELATED DOCUMENTS, AND THIS DEED OF TRUST. THIS DEED OF TRUST IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Deed of Trust, Grantor shall pay to Lander all amounts secured by this Deed of

Trust as they become due, and shall selectly and this simely menner perform all of Grantor's obligations under the Note, this Dead of Trust, and the Related Documents.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until the occurrence of an Event of Default, Grantor may (a) remain in possession and control of the Property, (b) use, operate or manage the Property, and (c) collect any Rente from the Property (this privilege is a Source from Lender to Grantor automatically revolved upon default). The following provisions relate to the use of the Property or to other antitations on the Property. The Real Property is not used principally for agriculture or farming purposes.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenentable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Mulamos, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nulsance not commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Specifically without limitation, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerale (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consumt of Lender.

Removed of Improvements. Granter shall not demote to remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lander. As a condition to the removal of any improvements, Lander may require Granter to make arrangements satisfactory to Lander to replace such improvements with improvements of at least equal value.

Lander's Right to Enter. Lander and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all remonable times to attend to Lander's interests and to inspect the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Deed of Trust.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply, and shall promptly cause compliance by all agents, tenants or other persons or entities of every nature whitecome who rent, lease or otherwise use or occupy the Property in any macraer, with all leave, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may context in good teth any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so leng as Granter has notified Lander in writing prior to doing so and so long as, in Lander's sole opinion, Lander's interests in the Property are not justicable. Lander may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surely bond, removably satisfactory to Lander, to protect Lander's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abandon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably recessory to protect and processes the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, (a) declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Deed of Trust or (b) increase the interest rate provided for in the Note or other document evidencing the indultedness and impress such other conditions as Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or interest makins the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest thereby, whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary, whether by outsight sale, deed, instringent sale contract, fanid contract, compact for deed, lessesheld interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property Interest. If any Grantor in a corporation or partnership, transfer she includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (20%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Londer if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Washington law.

TAXES AND LIESE. The following provisions relating to the tesses and liene on the Property are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Payment. Granter staff pay when due (and in all events prior to definquency) all taxes, special taxes, assessments, charges (including water and sewar), fines and impositions levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property five of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Landar under this Deed of Trust, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due and except as otherwise provided in this Deed of Trust.

Might Te Centest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good falls dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeoperdized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within filteen (15) days after the lien notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cosh or a sufficient concerns surely bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' fees or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lander as an additional obliges under any surely bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lander satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shell authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lander at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shell notify Lender at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, meterialmen's iten, or other tien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$600.00. Grantor will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Deed of Trust.

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Identifications of Insurance. Grantor shell procure and maintain policies of the insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any colinearance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender, together with such other insurance, including but not limited to hexaird, liability, business interruption, and boiler insurance, as Lender may reasonably require. Policies shall be written in form, amounts, coverages and bests reasonably acceptable to Lender and issued by a company or companies reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor, upon request of Lender, wit deliver to Lender from time to time the policies or certificates of insurance in form satisfactory to Lender, including stipulations that coverages will not be cancelled or diminished without at least ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender. Should the Real Property at any time become located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergeticy Management Agency as a special flood insurance area, Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood insurance to the extent such insurance is required and is or becomes available, for the item of the loan and for the full unpaid principal belance of the loan, or the maximum limit of coverage that is available, whichever is less.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Landar of any loss or damage to the Property if the estimated cost of repair or replacement exceeds \$500.00. Landar may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within fifteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Landar's security is impaired, Landar may, at its election, receive and retain the proceeds and apply the proceeds to the reduction of the

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Indebtedness, payment of any Sen affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the researchie cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default under this Deed of Trust. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not convention to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Deed of Trust, then to pay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the principal belance of the Indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid without interest to Grantor as Grantor's interests may appear.

Unexpired insurance of Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Deed of Trust at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of the Deed of Trust, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

Grantor's Report on Insurance. Upon request of Lender, however not more than once a year, Grantor shall furnish to Lender a report on each existing policy of insurance showing: (a) the name of the insurer; (b) the risks insured; (c) the amount of the policy; (d) it is properly insured, the than current replacement value of such properly, and the manner of determining that value; and (e) the expiration date of the policy. Grantor shall, upon request of Lender, have an independent appraisar setsfactory to Lender determine the cash value replacement obset of the Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Granter falls to comply with any provicion of this Deed of Trust, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lander expends in so doing will beer interest at the rate charged under the Note from the date incurred or good by Lender to the date of repsyment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be psyable on dermand, (b) be added to the belance of the Note and be apportioned among and be psyable with any installment psyments to become due during either. (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Note, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and psyable at the Note's maturity. This Deed of Trust also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to be Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEPENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Title. Grantor werrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, tree and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in tevor of, and accepted by, Lander in connection with this Deed of Trust, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to essecute and deliver this Deed of Trust to Lender.

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Defence of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the fewful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's the or the interest of Trustee or Lander under the Deed of Trust, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lander shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lander's dun choics, and Grantor will defiver, or cause to be delivered, to Lander such instruments as Lander may request from time to time to participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Granton's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation proceedings are a part of this Dead of Trust.

Application of Not Proceeds. It all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award to applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all ressonable costs, expenses, and ottornous' tess, Trustee or Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnsion is find, Grantor shall promptly notify Lander in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lander shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice at at Grantor's expense, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions religing to governmental taxes, feel and charges are a part of this Dead of Trust:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Direct of Treat and take whetever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lien on the Real Property. Grantor shall reinteres Lender for all teres, as described below, tegether with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Date of Trust, including without limitation all teres, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registering this Deed of Trust.

Taxes. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Dued of Trust or upon all or any part of the indebtedness secured by this Deed of Trust; (b) a specific tax on Granter which Grantor is authorized or required to disduct from payments on the indebtedness secured by this type of Dued of Trust; (c) a tex on this type of Dued of Trust chargeable against the Lander or the holder of the Note; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by Grantor.

Subsequent Taxes. If any tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Dead of Trust, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (se defined below), and Lunder may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Grantor either. (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Lians section and deposits with Lunder cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lander.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Deed of Trust as a security agreement are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes features or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to partect and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Deed of Trust in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, tile executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Deed of Trust as a financing statement. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property in a manner and at a piece reaconably convenient to Grantor and Lender and make it available to Lender within three (3) days after receipt of written demand from Lender.

Addresses. The mailing addresses of Grantor (debtor) and Lender (secured party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Deed of Trust may be obtained (each as required by the Uniform Commercial Code), are as stated on the first page of this Deed of Trust.

FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to further assurances and attorney-in-fact are a part of this Deed of Trust.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lender, cause to be tited, recorded, reflied, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of turther assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complets, perfect, continue, or preserve (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Note, this Deed of Trust, and the Related Documents, and (b) the items and security interests created by this Deed of Trust as first and prior liens on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor. Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lander in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

Attorney-In-Fact. If Grantor fails to do any of the things referred to in the preceding paragraph, Lender may do so for and in the name of Grantor and at Grantor's expense. For such purposes, Grantor hereby irrevocably appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact for the purpose of making, executing, delivering, filing, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the Indebtedness when due, terminates the line of credit, and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Deed of Trust, Lender shall execute and deliver to Trustee a request for full reconveyance and shall execute and deliver to Grantor suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on the evidencing Lender's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Any reconveyance fee shall be paid by Grantor, if permitted by applicable law. The grantee in any reconveyance may be described as the "person or persons legally entitled thereto", and the recitals in the reconveyance of any matters or facts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness of any such matters or facts.

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DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Deed of Trust.

Default on Indubtedness. Fallure of Grantor to realise any payment when due on the Indubtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Dead of Trust to make any payment for taxes or insurance, or any other payment necessary to prevent filing of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compliance Details. Failure to oraply with any other term, obligator, covenant or condition contained in this Deed of Trust, the Note or in any of the Related Documents. If such a failure is curable and if Grantor has not been given a notice of a breach of the same provision of this Deed of Trust within the preceding twelve (12) months, it may be cured (and no Event of Default will have occurred) if Grantor, after Lender sends written notice demanding cure of such failure: (a) cures the failure within lifesen (15) days; or (b) if the cure requires more than lifesen (15) days, immediately initiates steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and compliates all reasonable and necessary steps sufficient to produce compliance as soon as reasonably practical.

Breaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Deed of Trust, the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, false in any material respect.

Inselvency. The insolvency of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any just of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's edutance as a going business (it Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or Washington law, the death of any Grantor (it Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an Event of Default under this Dead of Trust.

Ferecleaure, etc. Commencement of foreclosure, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor against any of the Property. However, this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good fath dispute by Grantor as to the validity or resonableness of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and furnishes reserves or a surety bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

Breach of Other Agreement. Any breach by Grantor under the terms of any other agreement between Grantos and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whether educing now or later.

Events Affecting Guaranter. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guaranter of any of the indebtedness or such Guaranter dies or becomes incompetent or any Guaranter revokes any guaranty of the indebtedness. Lender, at its option, may, but shell not be required to, permit the Guaranter's estate to assume unconditionally the obligations arising under the guaranty in a manner antisfactory to Lender, and, in doing so, cure the Event of Delault.

FIGHTS AND INEMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Trustee or Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indicatedness. Lender shall have the right at its option to declare the entire indicatedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

Ferestessre. With respect to all or any part of the Red Property, the Trustee shall have the right to sucroise its power of sale and to foreclose by notice and sale, and Lender shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shell have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lander shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of and manage the Property and collect the Rents, installing amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the Indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of cent or use fees directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Granter invovcably designates Lender as Grantor's atternay-in-fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to registes the earne and collect the processes. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender may demand shall eatily the obligations for which the payments are made, whatter or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Appellet Reselver. Lender shall have the right to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding or pending foreclosure or cale, and to collect the Prents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the appears value of the Property exceeds the Indebtedness by a substantial arrownt. Employment by Lender shall not disquality a person from serving as a receiver.

Tensory at Sufference. If Grantor remains in possession of the Property after the Property is sold as provided above or Lender otherwise becomes unfind to possession of the Property upon default of Grantor, Grantor shall become a timent at sufference of Lender or the purchaser of the Property and shall, at Lander's option, either: (a) pay a reasonable rental for the use of the Property, or (b) vacate the Property immediately upon the demand of Lander.

Other Remedies. Trustee or Lander shall have any other right or remedy provided in this David of Trust or the Note or by law.

Indee of Sale. Lender shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and piece of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least two (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition. Any sale of Personal Property may be made in conjunction with any sale of the Real Property.

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hundry waives any and all rights to have the Property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, the Trustee or Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate seles. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Walver; Election of Remodies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Deed of Trust shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lander to pursue any remody provided in this Deed of Trust, the Note, in any Related Document, or provided by lew shall not exclude pursuit of any other remody, and an election to make expenditures or to take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Dood of Trust after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lander's right to declare a default and to exercise any of its remodies.

Atterneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender Institutes any sult or action to enforce any of the terms of this Deed of Trust, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and on any appeals. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender which in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest at the Note rate from the date of expenditure until repeid. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without firritation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lander's atterneys' fees whether or not there is a lawsuit, including atterneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining the reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, appraisal fees, title insurance, and fees for the Trustee, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Grantor step will pay any court costs, in addition to all other sums provided by law.

Plights of Trustee. Trustee shall have all of the rights and duties of Lender as set forth in this section.

POWERS AND COLIGATIONS OF TRUSTEE. The following provisions relating to the powers and obligations of Trustee (pursuant to Lender's instructions) are part of this Deed of Trust.

Powers of Trustee. In addition to all powers of Trustee arising as a matter of law, Trustee shall have the power to take the following actions with respect to the Property upon the written request of Lender and Grantor: (a) join in preparing and filing a map or plat of the Real Property, including the dedication of streets or other rights to the public; (b) join in granting any essentent or creating any restriction on the Real Property; and (c) join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this Deed of Trust or the interest of Lender under this Deed of Trust.

Obligations to Hotily. Trustee shall not be obligated to notily any other party of a pending sale under any other stust deed or lien, or of any action or proceeding in which Grantor, Lender, or Trustee shall be a party, unless required by applicable law, or unless the action or proceeding is brought by Trustee.

Trustee. Trustee shall meet all qualifications required for Trustee under applicable law. In addition to the rights and remodes set forth above, with respect to all or any part of the Property, the Trustee shall have the right to foreclose by judicial foreclosure, in either case in accordance with and to the full extent provided by applicable law.

Successor Trustee. Lender, at Lender's option, may from time to time appoint a successor Trustee to any Trustee appointed hereunder by an instrument executed and acknowledged by Lender and recorded in the office of the recorder of SKAMANIA County, Washington. The instrument shall contain, in addition to all other matters required by state law, the names of the original Lender, Trustee, and Grantor, the book and page or

the Auditor's File Number where this Deed of Trust is recorded, and the name and address of the successor trustes, and the instrument shall be executed and acknowledged by Lander or its successors in interest. The successor trustee, without conveyance of the Property, shall succeed to all the title, power, and duties conferred upon the Trustee in this Deed of Trust and by applicable law. This procedure for substitution of trustee shall govern to the exclusion of all other provisions for substitution.

NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Subject to applicable law, and except for notice required or slowed by law to be given in another menner, any notice under this Deed of Trust shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailed, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses shown near the beginning of this Deed of Trust. Any party may change its address for notices under this Deed of Trust by giving formal written notice to the other parties, specifying that the purpose of the incide is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any tien which has priority over this Deed of Trust. For notice purposes, Granton priority over this Deed of Trust. For notice purposes, Granton the holder and Trusts indicated at all times of Counted asserts address. agrees to keep Lender and Trustee informed at all times of Grantor's current address.

ORAL AGREEMENTS OR ORAL COMMITMENTS TO LOAN MONEY, EXTEND CREDIT, OR TO FOREBEAR FROM ENFORCING REPAYMENT OF A DEBT ARE NOT ENFORCEABLE UNDER WASHINGTON LAW.

MISCELLANGOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Deed of Trust

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Assendments. This Deed of Trust, together with any Related Documents, constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties as to the matters set forth in this Deed of Trust. No alteration of or amendment to this Deed of Trust shall be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment.

Annual Reports. If the Property is used for purposes other than Grantor's residence, Grantor shall furnish to Lender, upon request, a certified statement of net operating income received from the Property during Grantor's previous flecal year in such form and detail as Lender shall require.

That operating income" shall mean all cash receipts from the Property less all cash expenditures made in connection with the operation of the Property.

uplicable Law. This Deed of Trust has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Washington. This Deed of Trust will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Deed of Trust are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Deed of Trust.

Marger. There shall be no marger of the interest or estate created by this Deed of Trust with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Multiple Parties. All obligations of Grantor under this Deed of Trust shall be joint and several, and all references to Grantor shall mean each and every Grantor. This means that each of the persons signing below is responsible for all obligations in this Deed of Trust. 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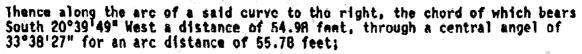
