CLAIM DESCRIPTION:

The point of discovery is past the end, to the south of USFS road #102 in the Randle District of the Gifford Pinchot National Forest, by approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, and approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile north of French Butte. The point of discovery is also approximately 20 yards south, up Greenhorn creek, tributary to Cispus River, from the south end of a logged off area located at the end of said road #102.

Approximate triangulation from high points on ridge to the East is 86° to a prominent rock point elevation 4840' and 24° to a more roundish point to the NE elevation 4549'. (See attached map)

Approximate elevation of discovery point is 4000'.

The apparent course of the vein exposed on the surface at the discovery point is 150° .

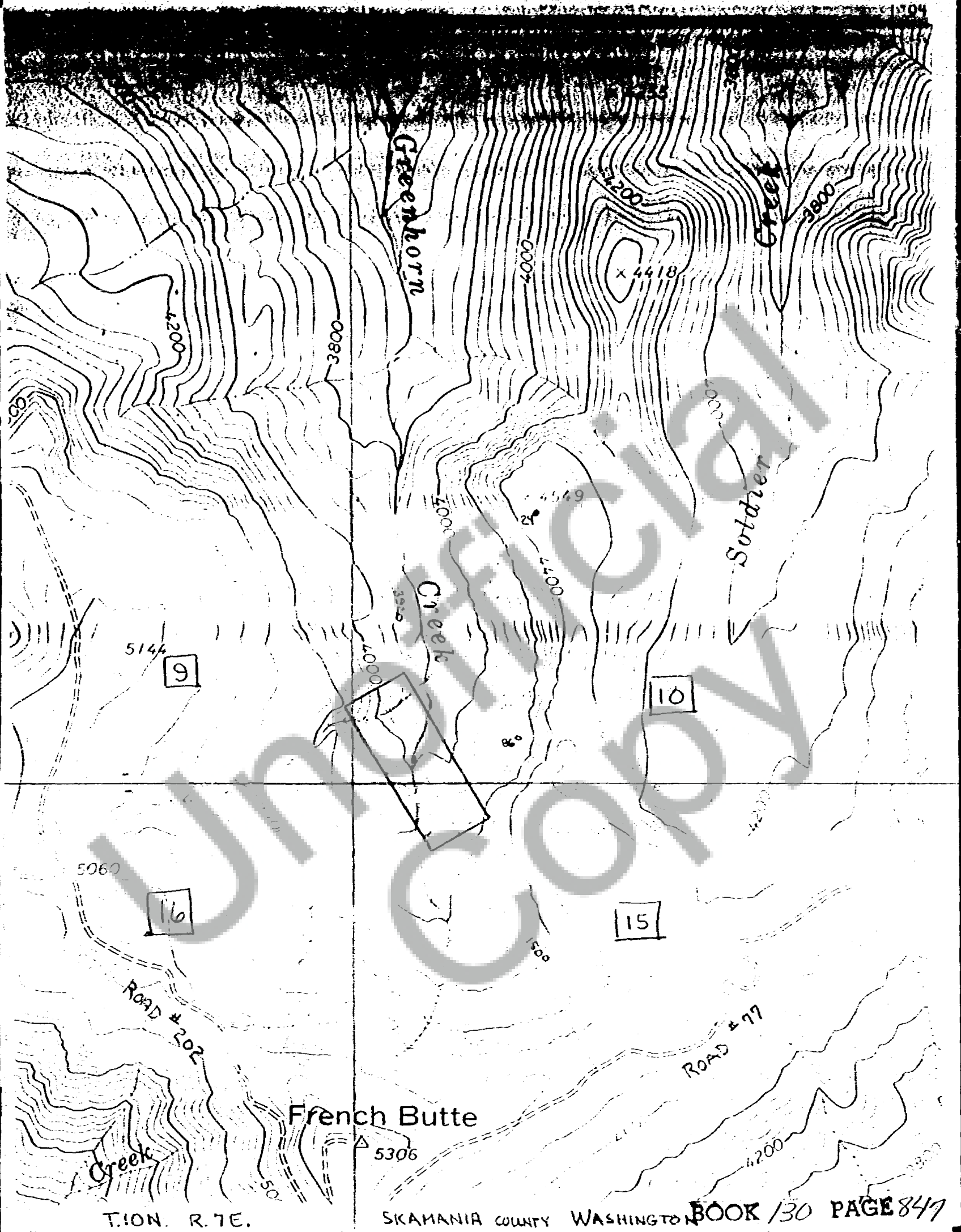
The claims width will be 300' on each side of the vein at the discovery point and the length will run approximately parallel to the vein, 800' SE of the discovery point and 700' NW of the discovery point.
