EASEMENT AGREEMENT

THIS EASEMENT AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 46Th day of 500000, 1992, by and between COLUMBIA GORGE INTERPRETIVE CENTER (hereinafter "Grantor), and the CITY OF STEVENSON, a municipal corporation of the State of WASHINGTON (hereinafter "Grantee").

WITMESSETH:

WHEREAS, Grantor is the owner of certain land situated in Skamania County on, over, under and across which the Grantee will install a wastewater outfall line, commonly known as the Stevenson Wastewater Outfall Line; and

WHEREAS, Grantee desires to obtain a permanent easement for the purpose of installing, maintaining and operating said wastewater outfall line.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of Grantee's promise to waive any fee for a sewer connection to the Columbia Gorge Interpretive Center and other mutual benefits to be derived, the parties agree as follows:

1. Grantor hereby grants and conveys to Grantee a perpetual, non-exclusive easement on, over, under and across a parcel of property in the Northwest quarter of Section 1, Township 2 North, Range 7 East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington, being the portion of that parcel of property described as Tract "A" which lies within that parcel of property described as Tract "B" below:

A parcel of property being 20.00 feet wide, lying 10.00 feet on each side of the following described center line:

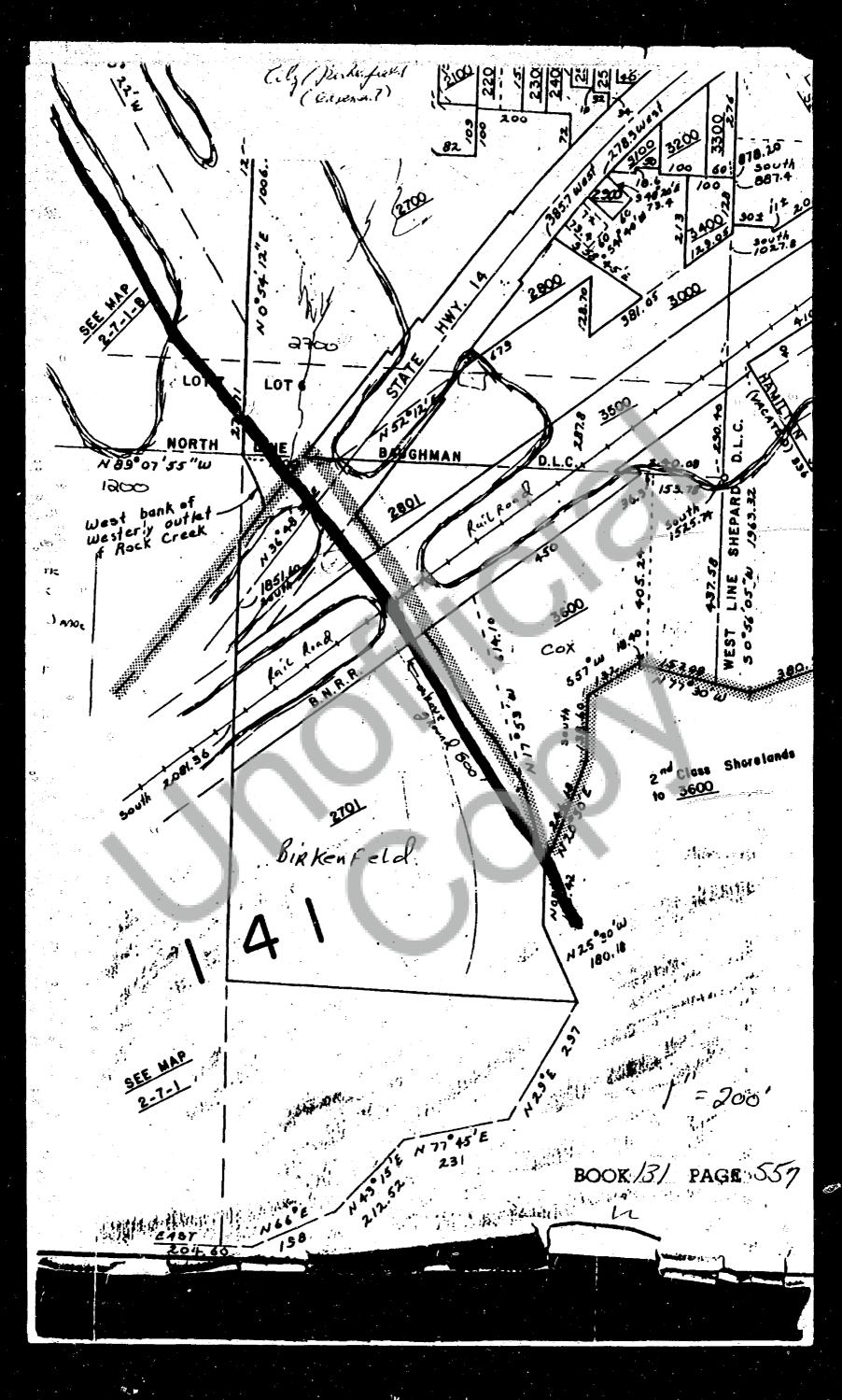

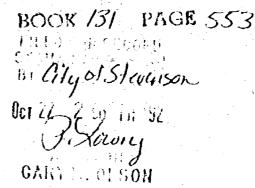

EASEMENT AGREEMENT

THIS EASEMENT AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 46Th day of 50000, 1992, by and between COLUMBIA GORGE INTERPRETIVE CENTER (hereinafter "Grantor), and the CITY OF STEVENSON, a municipal corporation of the State of WASHINGTON (hereinafter "Grantee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Grantor is the owner of certain land situated in Skamania County on, over, under and across which the Grantee will install a wastewater outfall line, commonly known as the Stevenson Wastewater Outfall Line; and

WHEREAS, Grantee desires to obtain a permanent easement for the purpose of installing, maintaining and operating said wastewater outfall line.
