EXHIBIT "A"

Assignment in Trust

(Lake Thin Timber Contract)

1. Assignment. For valuable consideration, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Multnomah Plywood Corporation ("MPC") hereby assigns, transfers, and sets over unto Security Pacific Bank Oregon ("SPBO"), in trust as security for the indebtedness hereinafter referred to, all of its interests, rights, and obligations under and by virtue of that certain timber sale Contract No. 063140, dated June 18, 1981, between MPC as purchaser and the United States of America, (the "Timber Contract") pursuant to which MPC agreed to purchase timber from an area of 356 acres, more or less, located in Sections 1, 2, 11, and 12, T.S.W. R.E., Section 36 T.8N., R. 8E., and Section 6, T.5N., R.9E., W.N., Unsurveyed, Skamania County, Washington. MPC also assigns, transfers, and sets over into SPBO all of MPC's interest in and rights to any balance on deposit with the United States to the credit of SPBO. This assignment is made in trust for the repayment of that certain indebtedness payable by MPC to the SPBO in accordance with the terms of that Debtor in Possession Credit Agreement, executed by MPC in favor of SPBO, dated May 17, 1991, and approved by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Oregon by order entered on May 20th, 1991 ("the Court Order").

2. Duty to Perform. It is understood that SPBO shall not be liable for nor have any responsibility for the performance of any of the obligations, agreements, and covenants undertaken, made, or assumed by MPC under the Timber Contract so long as SPBO has not entered into actual possession of MPC's rights under said Timber Contract, and until such time, MPC shall remain fully responsible and liable for the performance of any and all such obligations, agreements, and covenants under said Timber Contract. MPC hereby agrees to fully conform and comply with all such obligations, agreements, and covenants under the Timber Contract as long as any of the indebtedness secured by this Assignment remains outstanding. MPC also covenants and agrees to maintain said Timber Contract in good standing in all respects so long as any of said indebtedness does so remain outstanding.

3. Authority to Assign. Pursuant to the Court Order, this Assignment is being made pursuant to the authorization for assignment provided for in provision B8.4 of the Timber Contract and subject to all the limitations and conditions upon assignment, it being understood that this assignment is made in trust for the purpose of security of indebtedness and is intended to be in full conformity with the permission for assignment as contained in said provision B8.4, the provisions of said provision B8.4 being incorporated herein by reference.
